

HOW HURRICANE SMART ARE YOU?

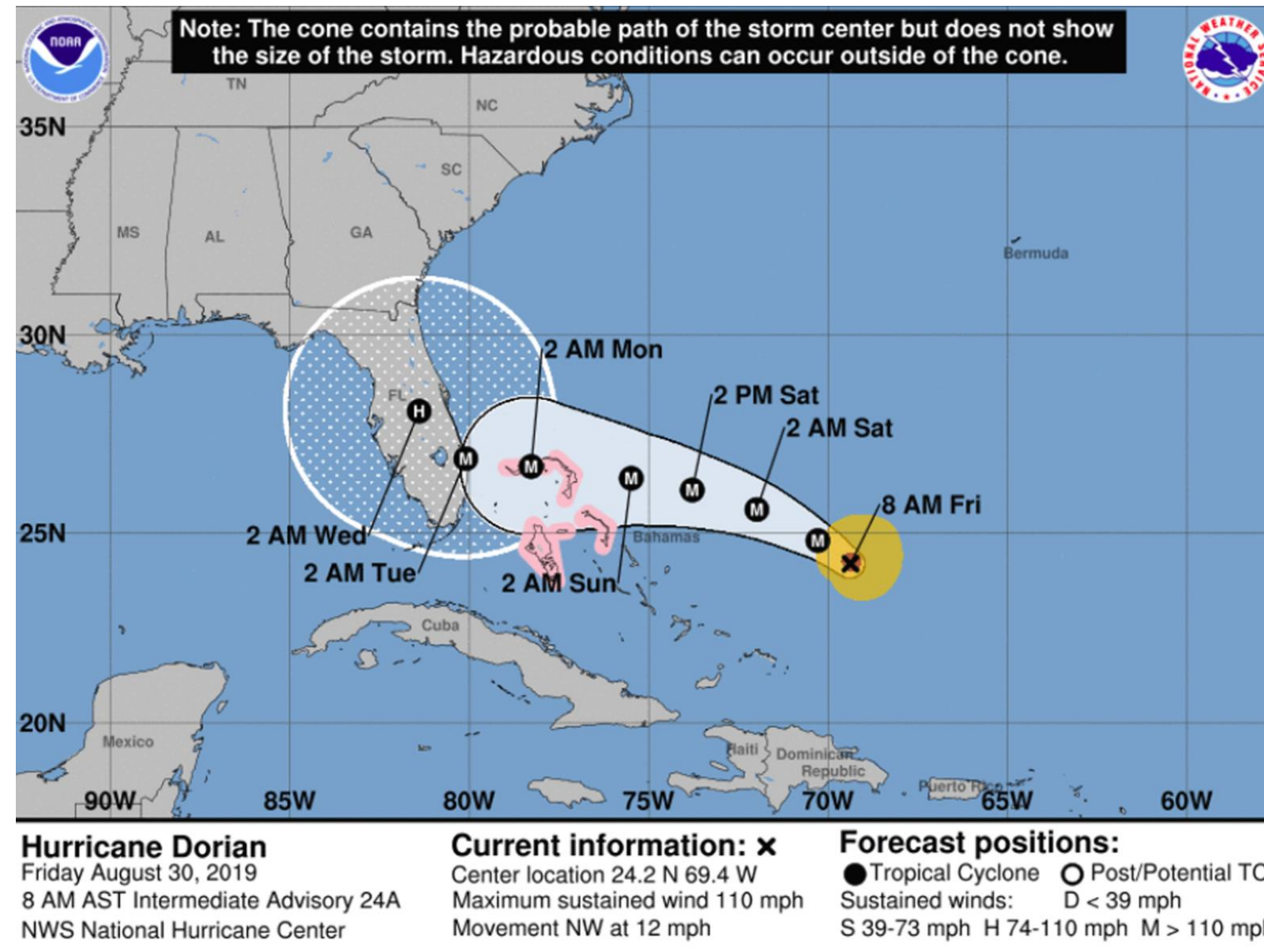
1. Do you know the difference between a Hurricane WATCH and WARNING?

KNOW HOW TO FIND AND INTERPRET NHC FORECAST GRAPHICS!

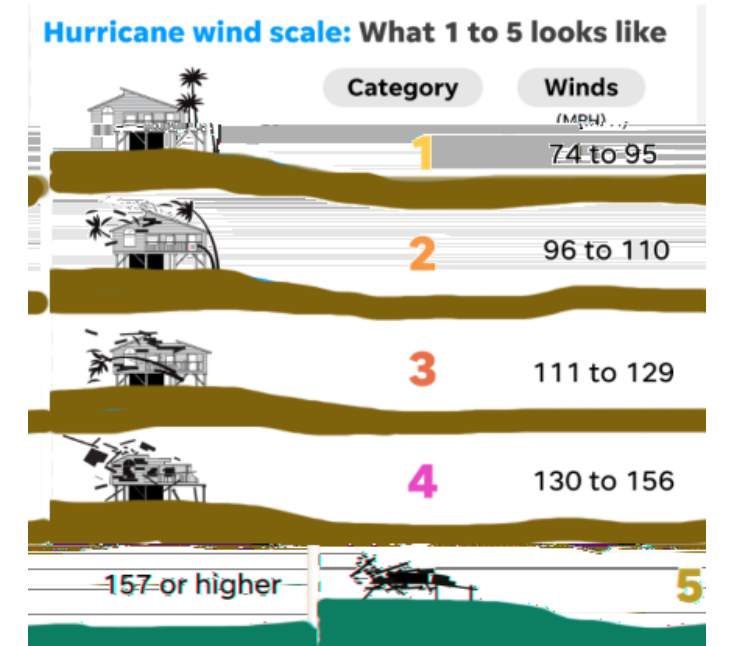
There's a RAP for that!

DON'T get in these SITUATIONS!

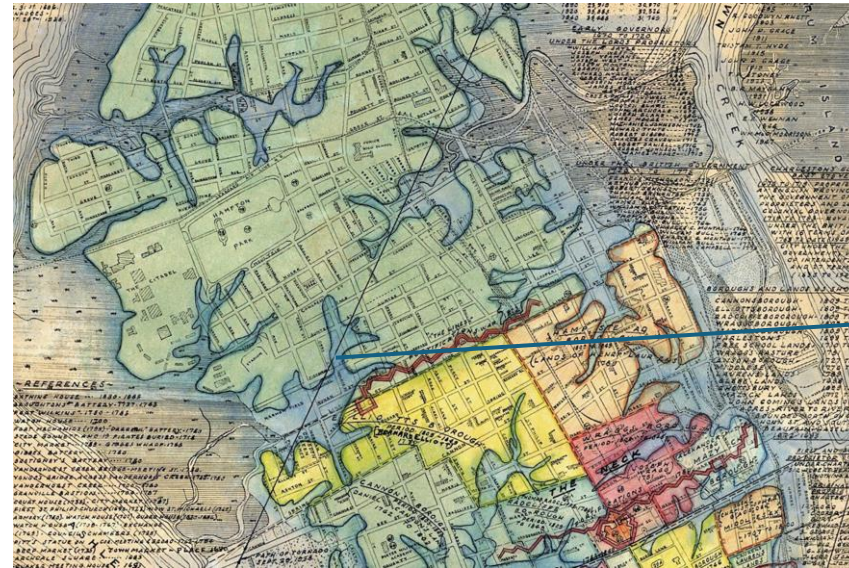
DANGER!

You don't pay any attention to the phase of the moon or the tide phase on a rainy day and head out on a trip and then drove through a flooded street!

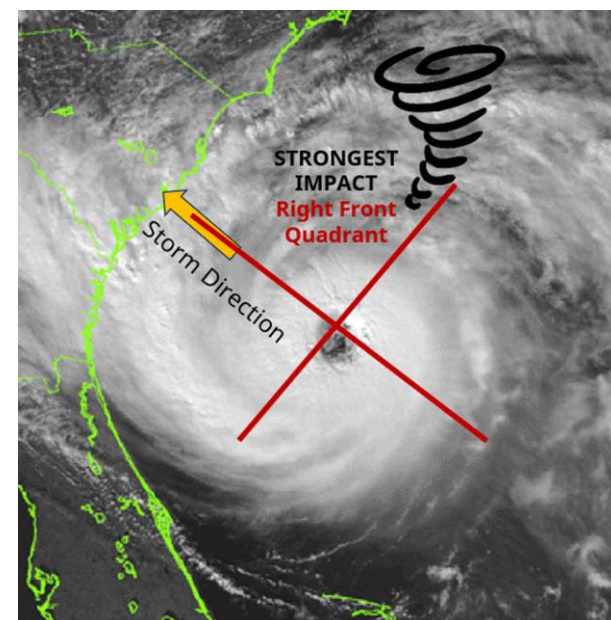
DANGER!

TIDE CHARTS, FORECASTS, LANDMARKS, APPS –

You got separated from your family, your cell phone died, and you did not have your written emergency contact numbers with you.

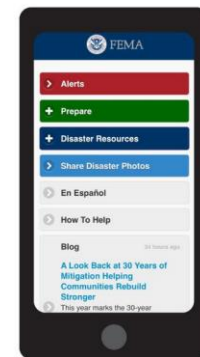
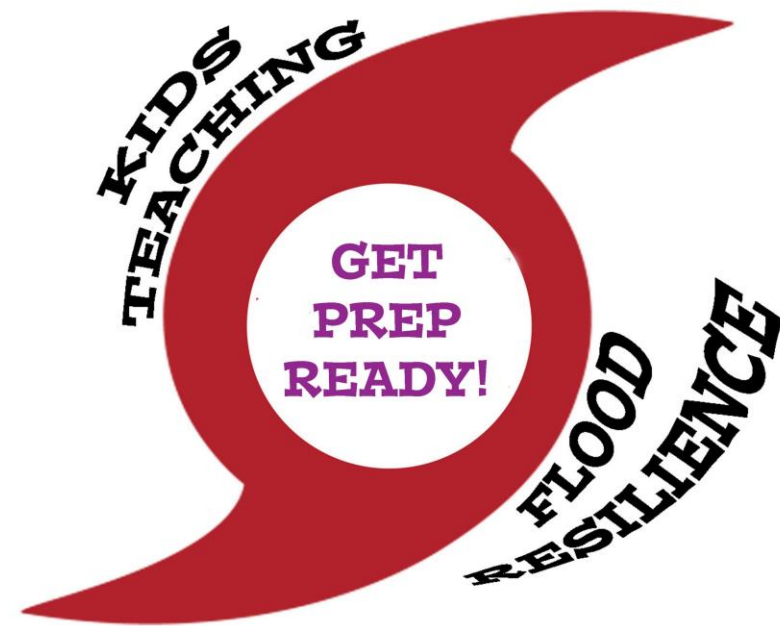
DANGER!
