**AN ORDER CONSENTING TO THE NOMINATION BY THE MAYOR OF CITIZEN OF THE CITY TO SERVE ON  
THE CITY OF PROSPECT CODE ENFORCEMENT BOARD AND AFFIXING TERM OF OFFICE THERETO**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Prospect has established a Code Enforcement Board to hear and adjudicate allegations of violations of ordinances of the City of Prospect; and

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance 601 of the City of Prospect, adopted on October 19, 2020, provides for 6 citizens, each of whom must be at least 21 years of age and a resident of the city for at least one year prior to their appointment, to serve on the Code Enforcement Board, 5 of whom as regular members and 1 as an alternate; and

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance 601 establishes the procedure for appointing members to the Code Enforcement Board; and

**WHEREAS**, two currently appointed members serve in other city committees and are disqualified to also serve on the code enforcement board by Ordinance Chapter 39.04 (2)(H);

**WHEREAS**, Mayor Farnsley nominates the following to serve a term as set forth herein, beginning August 1, 2024:

- Monette Beam is to serve a term of 3 years, ending on August 1, 2027.
- Richard Meyer is to serve a term of 3 years, ending on August 1, 2027.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PROSPECT, KENTUCKY:**

The City Council of the City of Prospect, Kentucky consents to the mayor's nomination to fill the above-stated position on the City of Prospect Code Enforcement Board for the term as stated.
