Closed low pressure aloft brought widespread precipitation to the Southwest United States including the Kern County Mountains and Desert from late Friday the 13th through much of Saturday the 14th. With the locally heavy rain roads were flooded as culverts clogged. Much of the rain fell in the early morning hours of the 14th when Democrat, in the mountains, received 0.96" of rain and Laural Mountain, in the desert, got 0.65" of rain.
