POST TROPICAL CYCLONE REPORT...TROPICAL STORM GASTON
NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE WILMINGTON NC
450 PM EDT FRI SEP 3 2004

GASTON WAS FIRST IDENTIFIED AS A TROPICAL DEPRESSION ON THE AFTERNOON OF FRIDAY, AUGUST 27, WHEN THE CENTER WAS 135 MILES SE OF CHARLESTON SC. A TROPICAL STORM WATCH WAS ISSUED FOR THE COAST OF GA, SC AND NC TO SURF CITY. ON THE MORNING OF THE 28TH, GASTON REACHED TROPICAL STORM STRENGTH AND A TROPICAL STORM WARNING WAS ISSUED FOR THE SC COAST. LATER THAT DAY THE SC COAST WAS ALSO PUT IN A HURRICANE WATCH, AND THAT NIGHT A HURRICANE WARNING WAS ISSUED FOR THE SC COAST WITH A TROPICAL STORM WARNING FOR THE NC COAST TO SURF CITY, AS A FLOOD WATCH AND TROPICAL STORM WIND WATCH WERE ISSUED FOR THE COUNTIES AWAY FROM THE COAST.

DURING THE MORNING OF THE 29TH GASTON STRENGTHENED AS IT APPROACHED THE COAST, AND THE TROPICAL STORM WIND WATCH FOR INLAND COUNTIES WAS UPGRADED TO A TROPICAL STORM WIND WARNING. AT ABOUT 10 AM, GASTON MADE LANDFALL IN CHARLESTON COUNTY SC AT BULLS BAY, JUST W OF MCCLELLANVILLE WITH WINDS AROUND 70 MPH, JUST BELOW HURRICANE STRENGTH. GASTON WEAKENED THAT DAY AND NIGHT AS IT MOVED INLAND OVER CHARLESTON COUNTY AND ACROSS BERKELEY, GEORGETOWN, WILLIAMSBURG AND FLORENCE COUNTIES. OVER MARION COUNTY, SUSTAINED WINDS FELL BELOW TROPICAL STORM STRENGTH (39 MPH), AND GASTON CROSSED DILLON COUNTY INTO NC DURING THE EARLY MORNING OF AUG 30.

HEAVY RAINS (SEE PART C.) CAUSED PONDING IN GEORGETOWN SC DURING THE
EARLY MORNING HOURS ON THE 29TH...WHICH SUBSIDED LATER IN THE

MORNING. WILLIAMSBURG COUNTY HAD FLOODING DURING THE DAY ON THE 29TH ACROSS THE WESTERN HALF OF THE COUNTY...WITH UP TO 5 FT OF WATER REPORTED IN A PARKING LOT IN KINGSTREE. WATER WAS STILL SUBSIDING IN THE LOW LYING AREAS LATER IN THE WEEK. FLASH FLOODING OCCURRED IN LAKE CITY (FLORENCE COUNTY) AND IN DARLINGTON DURING THE LATE AFTERNOON AND EVENING...FROM ABOUT 22Z TO 30/01Z

G. TORNADOES...

MARLBORO COUNTY SC - A F1 TORNADO OCCURRED AT ABOUT 1900Z, 4 MILES NE OF WALLACE, WITH A SPOTTY DAMAGE PATH ABOUT 1 MILE LONG AND UP TO MILE WIDE...CAUSING \$10K DAMAGE TO TREES AND BUILDINGS.

H. STORM EFFECTS...

DOWNED TREE LIMBS CAUSED SCATTERED POWER OUTAGES MAINLY IN SC. RAINWATER PONDING AND FLOODING...MAINLY IN SC.
