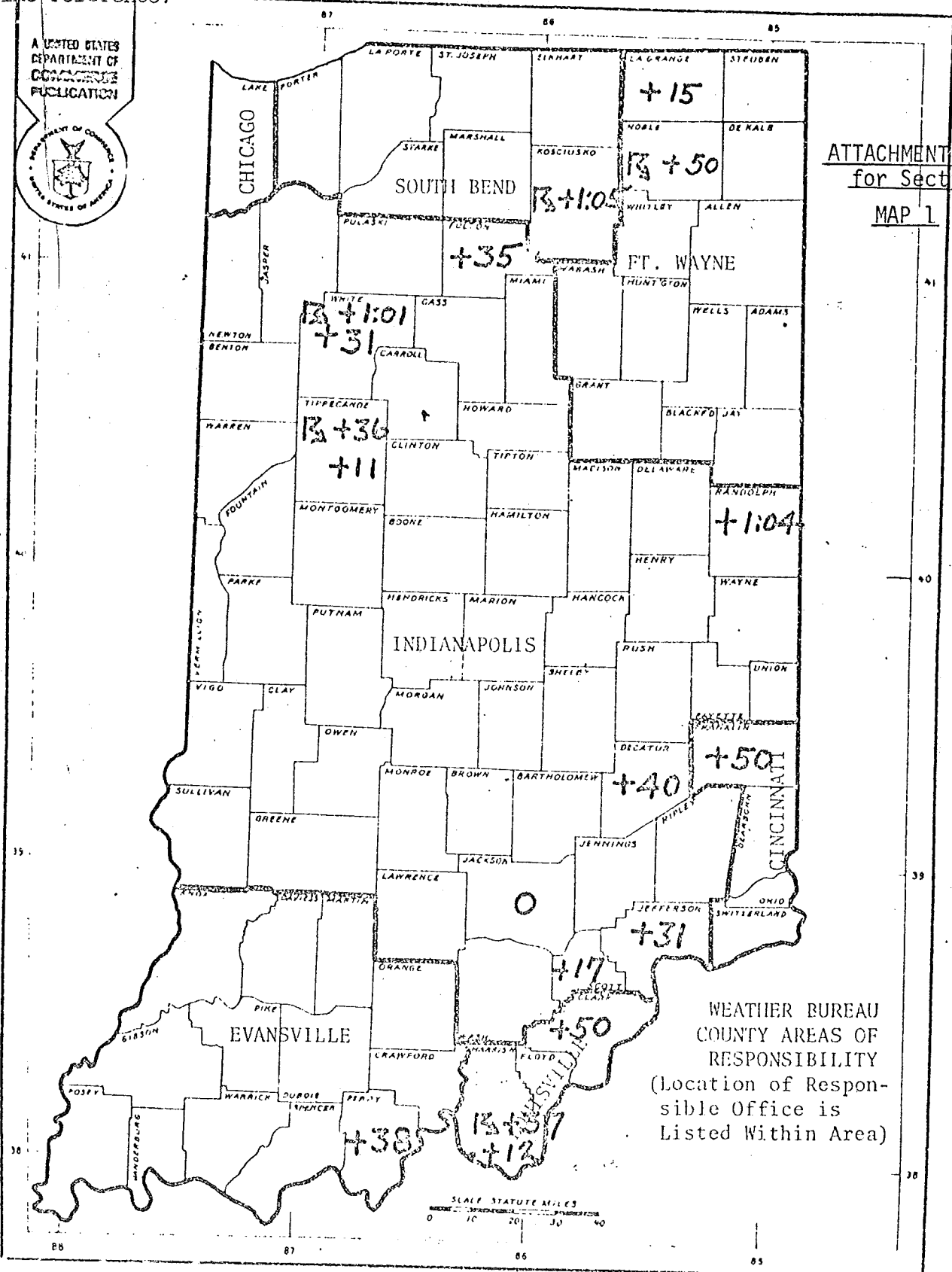

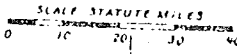

MAP 1

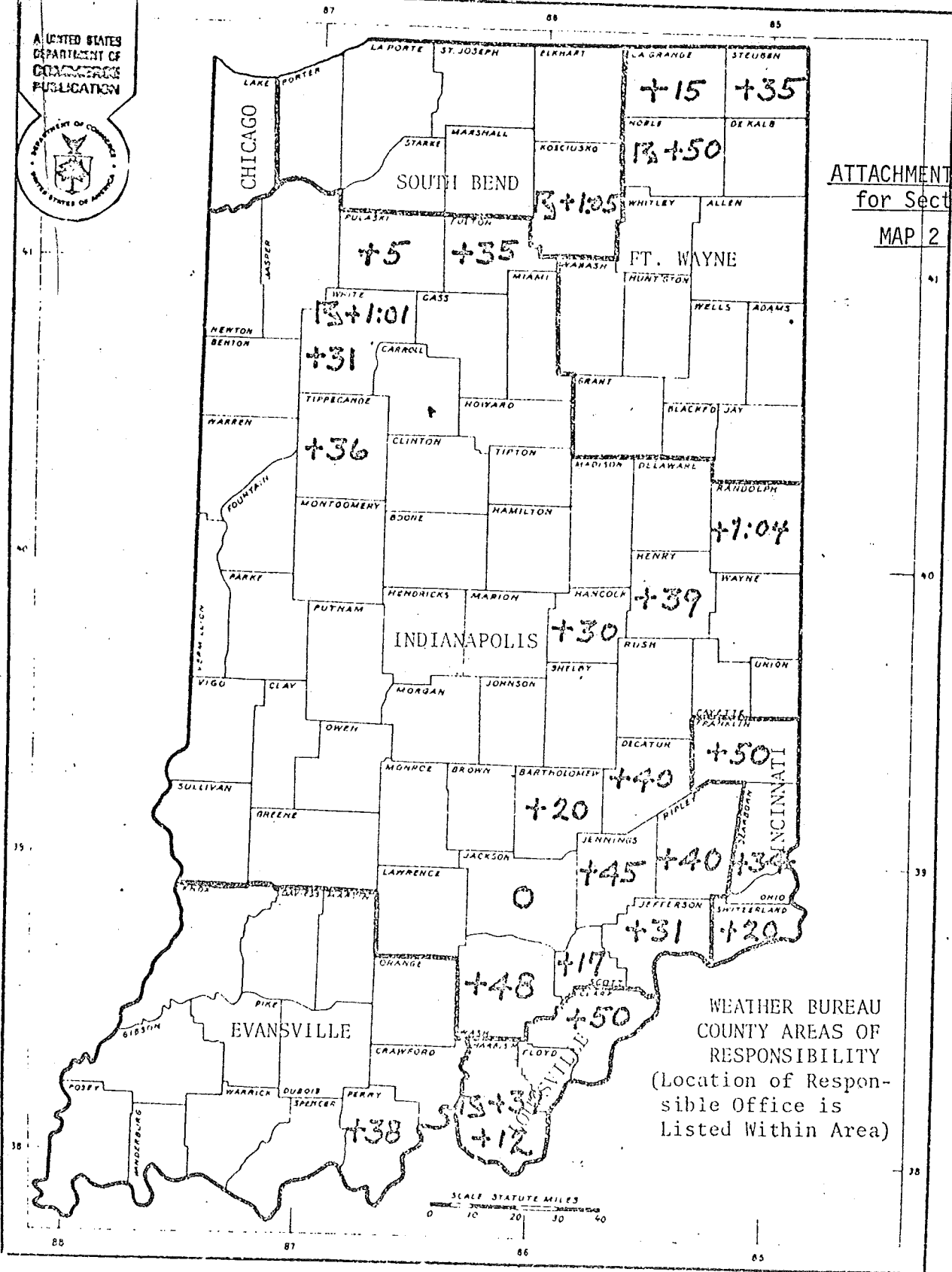
WEATHER BUREAU
