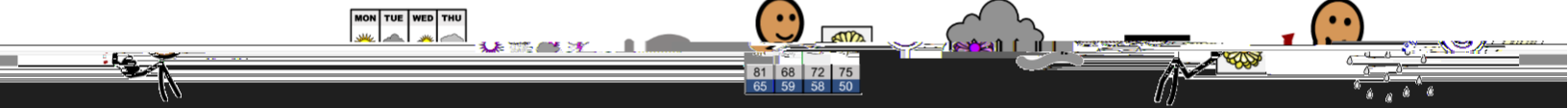

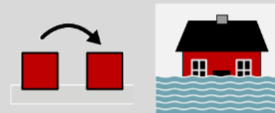

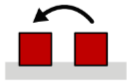

- stay calm,

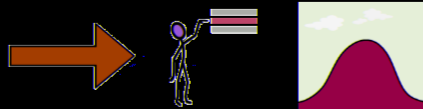
- listen to emergency alerts.

- and do not walk through floodwaters.



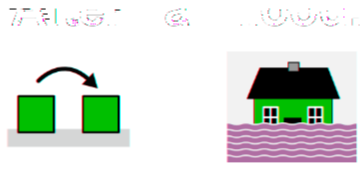

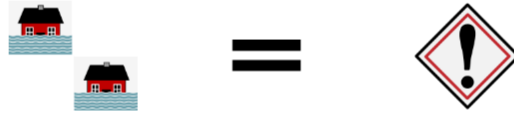
