Cold, in heavy fog, 30-40mph west wind, about 2 inches of slushy snow on the ground, road very slick coming up, temp=33F.

Observations not possible now, but there was clear sky visible to west from below this cloud deck that we're in.

MKIII COMMENT: Wed Feb 15 18:53:24 GMT 1995

Experienced problem with 4644 printer, print head ran away to right-end of platen. Cleaned optical sensor at left end-of-travel to fix.

WEATHER COMMENT: Wed Feb 15 21:01:47 GMT 1995

Still in heavy fog and strong westerly wind. Got a chance to see what's above and there is broken altocumulus above the fog layer. Clearing unlikely today.
