Either the valve is bent crashing into the ladder platform lip or the cover for the port (if there was one) vibrated off. I do not see it on the floor. I taped over the port with two layers of aluminum tape which seals the port off effectively.

Thin hole appeared to be approaching so I opened up dome and pointed spar but hole filled up with altocumulus before it reached us. Spar is unable to track effectively at this time.
