We were getting some drips while the shutter was facing East, so I decided to try different positions to minimize where they came in from. Unfortunately, regardless of where the dome is positioned, water is seeping through some bolts that are under the lip that hangs above the orange rings. I have found that having the dome slot face the North minimizes the drips from the dome slot as well as the number of bolts that has water seeping down it. I lightly covered t he instruments on the spar and have shut off power to the dome rotator. I also noticed the dome shimmy a bit when the wind kicks into high gear (30+).
