HOW DO URBAN BIRDS USE GREEN SPACES?

Help us find out. It's easy, fun, and quick!

Pick a time and outdoor place, watch birds for 10 minutes, and complete both sides of this form. Send the information to the Cornell Lab of Ornithology--even if you saw no birds.

HOW TO DO IT:

- A. Pick a date, time, and place (balcony, yard, park, etc.) for your birdwatch BEFORE you go out. Don't change your place or time just because you see an exciting bird elsewhere. That would bias your results. We'll ask you to describe and tell us the overall size of this place in questions 2 and 3. OPTIONAL: You can watch birds on one or two additional days in the same week.
- B. Set the bounds of your bird-watching area. Go to your chosen place and imagine a limited area around you that is about 50 feet x 50 feet (about the size of half a basketball court or 20 x 20 adult paces). Don't worry if your area is smaller than half a basketball court or if your view is limited to a smaller area. Just note that in question 5 below.
- C. At the time you selected, start your 10-minute bird watch, even if no birds are present when you begin. Fill out this form and send it to: Cornell Lab of Ornithology, 159 Sapsucker Woods Road, Ithaca NY 14850, or enter your observations online at www.CelebrateUrbanBirds.org. Send us your
