Mr. Stewart was brought to trial in
November 1957 on charges of conspiracy to
obtain information from the Government
in violation of the Espionage Laws.
The trial was held in the Federal Court
in New York City. The jury returned a
verdict of guilty on all counts.

Stewart was sentenced to a term of
imprisonment of 30 months and a
fine of \$10,000. He was also
debarred from holding any office
connected with the Government.
