Application for a temporary resident visa - checklist

- Complete and place this checklist on top of your application.
- Any document not in English or French must be accompanied by a certified translation.
- Failure to submit all required documentation may result in the refusal of your application or processing delays.
- False statements or submission of fraudulent documents will result in immediate refusal and potentially legal action.

All applicants must submit the following items:	
Family Information Form (IMM 5707), fully completed, dated and signed.	
Original passports and a copy of the passport bio-data page.	
 Passport should have a minimum of two blank visa pages and minimum 6 months validity. Your passport must be valid for the duration of your stay in Canada. 	
Include all previous passports, if applicable.	
If you do not reside in your country of citizenship, please provide evidence of your status in your country of residence.	
If you have answered "yes" to any of the background information questions on the application form, provide a completed and signed Schedule 1 form (Application for Temporary Resident Visa – IMM 5257B) and include it with your application.	

In addition to the above, submit the following based on your situation or purpose of travel:

CAN + - Applicants with previous travel to Canada in the past 10 years or currently	
hold a valid United States nonimmigrant visa	
If you have travelled to Canada in the last ten (10) years or currently hold a valid United States nonimmigrant visa and can provide proof (entry stamps in passport, proof of the valid visa), no proof of financial support is needed.	
For all others, provide proof of financial support to cover the expenses for the duration of your visit:	

If you are not paying for your own trip: Provide a letter signed by the person paying and a photocopy of their passport, or other official identification with photo and a bank certificate proving that they have sufficient funds. Describe how this person is related to you. These documents must be dated within three months of the date on which the application is submitted. Additional Required documents for parents and grandparents super visa **Letter of invitation** from your child or grandchild residing in Canada. One of the following documents to prove that your child or grandchild meets the **Low** Income Cut-Off (LICO) minimum: most recent copy of the Notice of Assessment; most recent copy of the T4 or T1. **Note:** If your child or grandchild does not have a paper copy of the Notice of Assessment on file, he or she can view (and print) tax returns as well as other personal tax information using the CRA's My Account online service. To register or login, visit My Account. Proof of parental relationship to your child or grandchild (copy of birth certificate or other official document naming you as parent). **Proof that your child or grandchild** is a Canadian citizen or permanent resident. Proof of medical insurance with a minimum \$100,000 coverage for one year with a Canadian insurance company (copy of insurance certificate or policy). Additional Required documents for other visitors **Letter of employment on official company letterhead** specifying the following: your position, length of employment and income; the full address and phone numbers for the company and the name and position of the person signing the letter. **Self-employed persons:** Provide proof of business income and income tax paid Proof of sufficient funds to cover expenses for the duration of your visit. A bank statement covering the last six months and showing the balance of the account; Any additional relevant documentation (payslips, investments, certificates of deposit, etc.). If you are not paying for your own trip, indicate how your trip will be funded. Submit supporting documentation, for example: parents' bank statements; letter from employer covering costs; spouse's employment, proof of employment and financial documents for host in Canada (employment letter, pay slips, T4/Notice of Assessment, bank statements), etc.

Explain the purpose of your trip (as applicable):	
 details of your itinerary in Canada; provisional travel arrangements (airline or hotel booking); letter of invitation from the person or business you will visit; registration at a conference, letter from your employer. 	
Additional Required documents for Seafarers:	
Valid seafarer booklet and certificate.	
POEA exit permission certificate.	
Employment contract.	
Letters from Canadian and local manning agencies with vessel joining details.	
Additional Required documents for RETURNING workers and student	ts:
Students: Current or valid Canadian Study Permit; Proof of current status - letter from educational institution confirming enrolment and date you are expected to resume studies.	
Workers: Current or valid Canadian Work Permit; Letter from Employer stating that you are expected to return to Canada and resume employment.
