JEFFERSON DAVIS MONUMENT 22 acres, nine miles to east of Hopkinsville on US 68. A monument to the memory of the President of the Confederacy, is 351 feet high. Elevator to top of monument. Jefferson Davis was born in 1808 at this location.

CHEROKEE RESORT PARK (The South's finest vacation park for Negroes) is located on US 68 and KY 80 near the western approach of Eggner's Ferry Bridge. Furnished housekeeping cottages and dining room. Park fronts west shore of Kentucky Lake. Developed beach, modern bath house, and boat dock.
