



## TRANSFER PATHWAY GUIDE 2023-2024

Associate in Arts to Bachelor of Science in Community  
and Leadership Development

### Overview

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for an Associate in Arts at the Kentucky Community and Technical College System and leads to a Bachelor of Science in Community and Leadership Development at the University of Kentucky.

### Admission Requirements

Students must meet the University admission requirements to be admitted into any major within the Martin-Gatton College of Agriculture, Food and Environment.

KCTCS students planning to transfer to the University of Kentucky should work closely with a UK Transfer Advisor each semester to ensure that both KCTCS and UK degree requirements are met.

### Degree Requirements

The Martin-Gatton College of Agriculture, Food and Environment requires that students complete an approved academic enrichment experience, 45 credit hours at the 300-level or higher, and 120 cumulative credit hours.

- Prefer COM 101, COM 249, COM 257, SOC 101, POL 101, and/or GEN 140 to satisfy the Social Science requirements
