Associate in Science to Bachelor's in Information Communication Technology (ICT)

### Overview

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy both the requirements for an Associate in Science at KCTCS as well as UK Core requirements for the University of Kentucky for a Bachelor's Degree in Information Communication Technology.

### **Admission Requirements**

The College of Communication is a selective admission college and requires a 2.0 cumulative GPA.

KCTCS students planning to transfer to the University of Kentucky should work closely with a UK Transfer Advisor each semester to ensure that both KCTCS and UK degree requirements are met.

### **Degree Requirements**

If the student elects to pursue a Bachelor of Science in ICT or chooses Option B under the Bachelor of Arts, the Foreign Language requirements will differ. Please consult a UK Advisor in such an instance.
