(g) No swine exhibitions shall be conducted after March 1 of each year, except for the Oklahoma Youth Expo until its conclusion.

(1) If a premium sale is conducted after March 1, the swine may not return for the event.

(2) A swine exhibition permit shall not be approved pursuant to (g) above.

(3) If proof exists of a swine being exhibited after March 1, that swine and any other swine from the same premises are prohibited from attending the Oklahoma Youth Expo.

I understand all swine present at this event shall meet the following requirements and that these requirements must be verified before swine are allowed on the event premises:

- Verification of a federal premised identification number (PIN) or state location identifier (LID).
- Individual identification
 - Oklahoma origin swine shall be identified by both ear notch and an official electronic 840 button tag (EID/RFID).
 - Out-of-state swine shall be identified by ear notch and any form of official identification.
- Brucellosis and pseudorabies testing (Must meet one of the following options):
 - Prior to changing ownership, all swine six months of age or older, shall be tested and found negative to pseudorabies and brucellosis within the previous thirty (30) days or originate from a V/Q herd with current test status.
 - Oklahoma origin swine ONLY: negative brucellosis and pseudorabies tests after May 15th for fall events and after November 10th for spring events. Test results, laboratory name, and animal identification shall be listed on a valid CVI or Oklahoma swine test chart.
 - Out-of-state swine shall have an ODAFF approved import permit number listed on the CVI. Electronic CVI's are exempt from the permit requirement. **All ages shall be tested and found negative to pseudorabies and brucellosis within thirty (30) days of travel or originate from a V/Q herd with current test status and VQ herd number included on the CVI.**

I understand that it is my responsibility as the event coordinator to submit the following records to ODAFF within 15 days after the event:

- Name, address, phone number, and federal PIN or state LID for all participants.
- Individual identification, age, breed, and sex of all swine.

Electronic spreadsheet is the preferred format for this record; however, other hardcopy records are acceptable. The event coordinator is not required to maintain these records once ODAFF has verified receipt.
