

# Cattle Exhibition Requirements



Cattle must be officially identified prior to exhibition. The following are approved official identification for cattle.

*Official ID may not be removed from an animal once it is applied.*

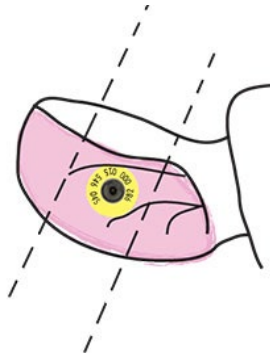
## 1. Radio Frequency Identification Device (RFID) tags

- Consists of 15 digits, beginning with **840** for the U.S.
- Both Visual and Radio Frequency Identification (RFID).
- Producers can obtain RFID tags from an accredited veterinarian, or directly from the manufacturer with proof of a premises identification number.



## 2. Breed Registry Tattoos or Tags

- Acceptable if accompanied by documentation listing the breed registration number.
- Pending registrations are not acceptable.



# Swine Exhibition Requirements



Breeding and feeding swine must be officially identified prior to exhibition. The following are approved official identification for swine.

## 1. National Uniform Ear Tagging System (NUES)

- Begins with the official state number; **43** or **MO** for Missouri.

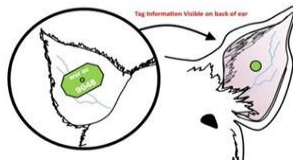


## 2. Animal Identification Number (AIN) System

- Consists of 15 digits, beginning with **840** for the U.S.
- Visual and Radio Frequency Identification (RFID).
- Producers can obtain RFID tags from an accredited veterinarian, or directly from the manufacturer with proof of a premises identification number.

## 3. ear notch or a registration tattoo, if purebred

- Acceptable if accompanied by documentation listing the breed registration number.
- Pending registrations are not acceptable.
