●By Car

Only a short walk from Kawashima Parking Area Highway Oasis of the Tokai Hokuriku Expressways (E41). Via surface-streets: 10-minute drive from both Ichinomiya Kiso River Interchange and the Gifu Kakamigahara Interchange. ※Parking is free.

●By Trains and Buses

Take the Gifu bus Kasamatsu-Kawashima Line from Meitetsu Kasamatsu Station and get off at "Kasen Kankyo Rakuen" stop. Alternatively, you can take a taxi from JR Kisogawa Station or Meitetsu Shinkisogawa Station.

※We may extend the open hours depending on the season.

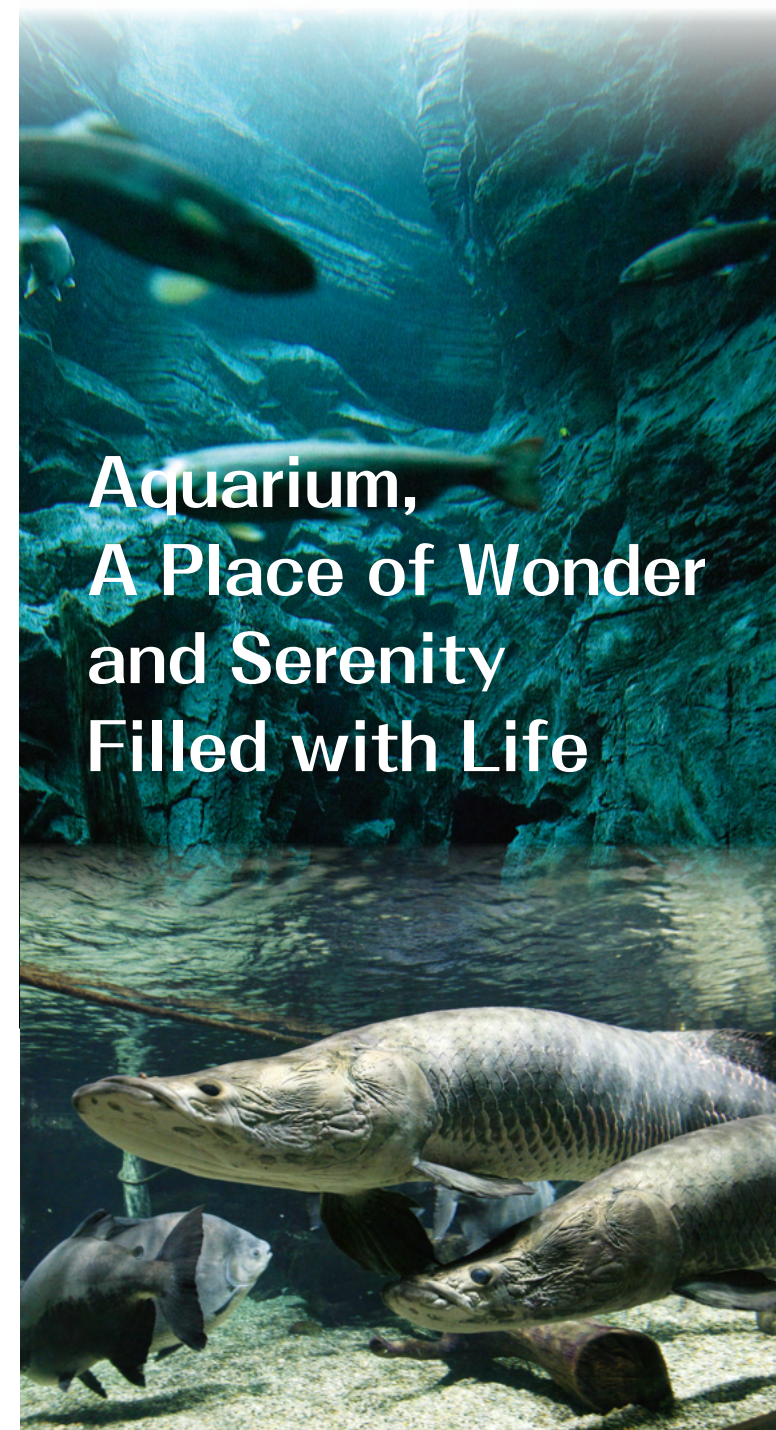
[Closing Date] Open throughout the year.

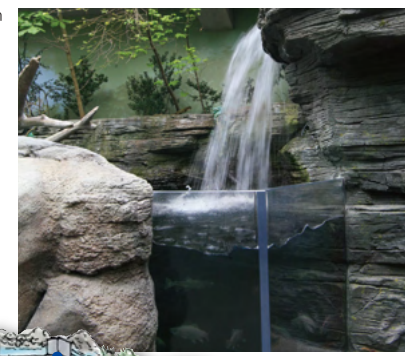
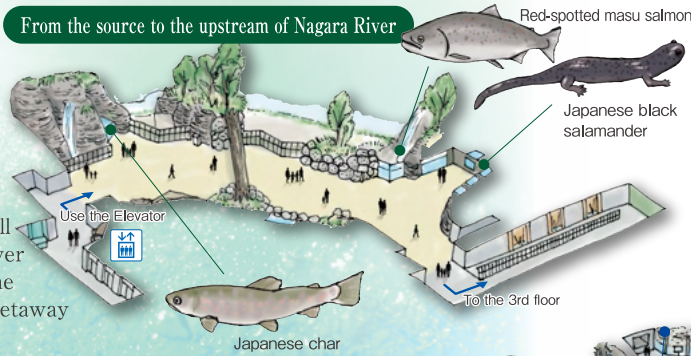

This is the photo of a Japanese black salamander. They live in a deep forest of the mountainous areas. This forest inhabitant is hard to spot because they usually hide themselves under fallen leaves and mud.

When you look inside the tank (an imitation of a waterfall basin), you will see a Red spotted masu salmon swimming in a leisurely manner. Red spotted masu salmon is the symbol of Nagara River, and considered as a dream fish among fishing lovers.

A Nostalgic Archetypal Image of Japan

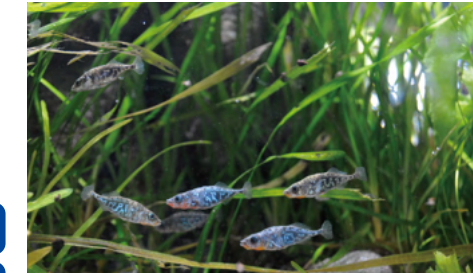
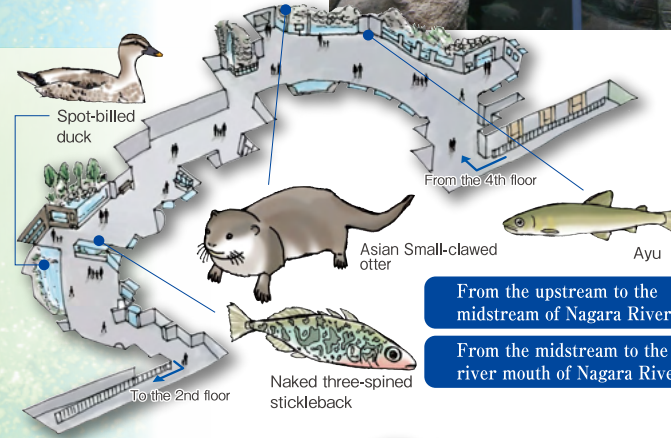
From the upstream to the mouth of Nagara River

The tank reproduces the scenery of Nagara River from its upstream to the river mouth. It is so real that it seems as though it's been cut out from the actual scenery.

You can also meet some of the endangered freshwater fishes which are in danger of becoming extinct due to environmental changes.



Japanese river otter has gone extinct, but meet the Asian Small-clawed otter instead. We hold the Feeding Show three times a day. Come and watch how they use their dexterous forelegs to eat their food.
