- d) Aggregated data is available to universities for the purpose of acknowledging or monitoring collective achievements of program graduates

Cookies

Confidentiality and nondisclosure is also a requirement of eligibility to sit for the CHES® or MCHES® exam. If you do not accept the confidentiality agreement, your CHES® and MCHES® certificate may be revoked.

Release of Info Policy

The CHES® and MCHES® exam score result is confidential and will not be disclosed unless NCHEC receives a written request to do so from a candidate, or is directed to do

so by subpoena or court order. A candidate wanting scores released to another entity must indicate in writing which particular scores may be disclosed, and identify specifically the person or organization to which the scores should be revealed. No candidate scores will be given by telephone, facsimile or e-mail for any reason.

NCHEC does not consider the CHES® and/or MCHES® current status (“active” or “lapsed”) of a certificate holder as confidential. NCHEC reserves the right to provide information on the current status of a certificate holder.
