CONSENT AGREEMENT

The Commercial Licensing Division ("Division") of the Rhode Island Department of Business Regulation ("Department") enters into this Consent Agreement ("Agreement") with David Angellotti d/b/a Dave's Auto Salvage ("Respondent") to resolve the above-captioned matter pursuant to its authority under R.I. Gen. Laws § 42-35-9(d).

It is hereby agreed by and between the Division and the Respondent that:

- The Respondent operates a salvage yard at 43 Shippee School House Road,
 Foster, Rhode Island (the "premises").
- 2. On or about November 12, 2014, the Department's Chief Public Safety Inspector inspected the premises and observed 14 unregistered junk vehicles, 200 or more used tires, 200 or more used rims, a tire mounting/dismounting machine, and acetylene gas canisters used for acetylene torches.
- 3. Pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws § 42-14.2-3, "[n]o person shall establish or operate an auto wrecking yard or auto salvage yard without a license therefor."
- 4. Pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws § 42-14.2-1(b) "Auto wrecking yard" or "auto salvage yard," "means land upon which a person, firm, corporation, or association

destroys, junks, dismantles, or stores for later dismantling or destruction motor vehicles or parts thereof, and may engage in the sale of used motor vehicle parts, or scrap therefrom."

- 5. In order to timely and amicably resolve this matter, the Respondent agrees to:
 - A. Remove all unregistered vehicles on the premises within three (3) weeks of the date of this Agreement;
 - B. Cease and desist from unlicensed auto salvage work on the premises; and
 - C. Pay an administrative penalty of \$500.00 payable to "General Treasurer, State of Rhode Island."
- 6. By signing this Agreement, Respondent voluntarily waives any right to an administrative hearing or appeal to Superior Court under the Rhode Island Administrative Procedures Act, R.I. Gen. Laws § 42-35-1 et seq.
- 7. If Respondent fails to abide by the requirements of this Consent Agreement, the Department may initiate further administrative proceedings against the Respondent.
