CONSENT AGREEMENT

The Division of Commercial Licensing (“Division”) of the Rhode Island Department of Business Regulation (“Department”) enters into this Consent Agreement (“Agreement”) with Robert Pisaturo and Renata Jarosv d/b/a Legacy Auto Body (“Respondents”) to resolve the above-captioned matter pursuant to its authority under R.I. Gen. Laws § 42-35-9(d).

It is hereby agreed by and between the Division and the Respondents that:

1. Legacy Auto Body is a business located at 1707 Plainfield Pike in, Johnston, Rhode Island (the “premises”).
2. On April 1, 2014, the Department’s Chief Public Safety Inspector performed an inspection during which he observed Respondent Pisaturo operating an auto body repair shop on the premises without a license.
3. The Division acknowledges Respondents’ efforts to comply with statutory requirements, desire to remedy the violations, and willingness to cooperate with the Division in resolving this matter.

4. In order to resolve this matter amicably without necessitating a formal evidentiary hearing, the Division agrees to grant a license to Respondent Jarosv to operate a full collision repair shop at the premises, if and only if:
 - A. A full application is submitted, with all statutory and regulatory requirements being satisfied, including payment of the application fee.
 - B. Respondents pay an administrative penalty in the total amount of \$1,000.00, payable with payments of \$150.00 each month until paid in full.
5. Respondent Jarosv acknowledges that upon being licensed she is liable under R.I. Gen. Laws § 5-38-11, which provides “[e]ach licensee shall be responsible...for the acts of any...employee acting as the agent for that licensee.”
6. By signing this Agreement, Respondents voluntarily waive any right to an administrative hearing or appeal to Superior Court under the Rhode Island Administrative Procedures Act, R.I. Gen. Laws § 42-35-1 *et seq.*
7. By signing this Agreement, Respondents acknowledge and understand that should Respondents violate the terms of this Consent Agreement and/or engage in any other administratively, criminally, or civilly sanctionable conduct, the Department retains full authority to refuse to issue an automobile body repair license, or, if granted, to revoke, suspend, fine, or refuse to renew the license, after notice and opportunity for hearing.
