ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On or about April 3, 2014, MDLLII LLC (“Appellant”) filed an appeal with the Department of Business Regulation (“Department”)¹ appealing a decision by the Providence Board of Licenses (“Board”) to suspend its liquor license (“License”) for two (2) days and impose an administrative penalty of \$1,000 on its License. 
