COMMENT DATES FOR THE VRS COMPENSATION NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING

CG Docket Nos. 03-123 and 10-51

Comment Due Date: July 15, 2021 Reply Comment Due Date: July 30, 2021

On May 21, 2021, the Federal Communications Commission (Commission) released a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (NPRM) seeking comment on Telecommunications Relay Services (TRS) Fund compensation for providers of video relay service (VRS).¹ According to the NPRM, comments are due 30 days after publication in the Federal Register, and reply comments are due 45 days after such publication.²

A summary of the NPRM was published in the Federal Register on June 4, 2021 that inadvertently omitted the due dates for comments and reply comments.³

On June 15, 2021, a correction to the summary was published in the Federal Register, which provides that comments on the NPRM must be filed on or before July 15, 2021 and reply comments must be filed on or before July 30, 2021.⁴
