There are two ways you can register to vote in New Hampshire, you can:

- register to vote at your local city/town clerk's office at least 10 days before the date of a primary or general election; or
- \checkmark register to vote at the place of polling on the day of the election.

The Power of the Disability Vote

Turnout Has Increased

One in five Americans, including nineteen percent of likely voters, experience a disability. They, along with their families, friends and allies, vote. A recent Rutgers University study noted that between the 2018 and 2022 midterm elections, voter turnout among people with disabilities grew by 1.6 points, which helped to reduce the turnout gap compared to voters without disabilities. This data shows that candidates ignore us at their own peril.

The Disability Voter Gap Persists

If people with disabilities voted at the same rate as those without disabilities, an additional 2 million votes would be cast. Make sure yours is one of them.
