Task	Hazard	Cause	Prevention
General Use	Eye injury	Fumes, splashes and dusts (cleaning agents)	Goggles, face shield
	Trauma	Sharp objects, impact	Situational awareness, gloves
	Foot Injury	Dropped items	Safety Toe Boots
	Ingestion	Splash, spills, poor work practices	Googles, face shield, no eating drinking, tobacco use. Do not touch hands to face or mouth.

PPE Required

- Googles / Face Shield
- Gloves
