Task	Hazard	Cause	Prevention
General Use	Foot Injury	Improper placement of load	Wear safety shoes Situational awareness,
	Trauma	Overloading engine stand beyond rated capacity	Follow manufacturer's instructions. Ensure that rated load is legibly and permanently on engine stand, and rated capacity is not exceeded.
