Hazard Analysis:

Snow Blower, Gasoline Powered

Task	Hazard	Cause	Prevention
General Use	Eye Injury	Flying debris (ice, rocks, snow, etc)	Safety glasses w/side shields
	Trauma	Flying debris, Rotating parts, Burns, frostbite	Situational awareness, protective clothing, gloves
	Foot Injury	Equipment rolls over/drops on foot	Safety shoes/boots
	Noise	Equipment Operation	Hearing protection

PPE Required:

- Safety Glasses w/side shields (only when frostbite hazard does not present a greater hazard) protective Clothing Hearing Protection
- Safety shoes/boots
- Gloves

This document serves as the Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Certification document required to satisfy the federal requirements of the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) Standard, 29 CFR 1910.132 Subpart I- Personal Protective Equipment.
