# **APL Wireless Internet Access for Instructors**

### Two items are needed prior to connecting:

- SSID and WPA2-PSK Key for access point
- UNIX Account username and password

#### **Wireless Access Point**

SSID JHU-EP

WPA2-PSK Key TextBook (case sensitive)

# UNIX Accounts for <u>instructors</u> can be obtained by submitting an online request:

- 1. Go to the website http://apl.jhu.edu
- 2. Scroll to the bottom of the page.
- 3. On the left side of the page, click the link titled "Instructor & Staff UNIX Account Form"
- 4. Fill out the application and click the "Submit Request" button.
- 5. You will be contacted with your account information in a few days.

# Wireless login procedure:

- 1. Connect to the JHU-EP wireless access point.
- 2. If a password is requested, enter the provided WPA2-PSK key.
  - a. If you have previously logged on the JHU-EP wireless access point, your computer may have saved the WPA2-PSK key and you may not need to enter it again.
- 3. Once that connection is made, open up a web browser.
- 4. Upon trying to access any web page, you will be redirected to a login page.
- 5. Enter your UNIX account information.
- 6. You should receive a confirmation message.
- 7. You are now logged on to the wireless!
