# Wrocław accessibility by air

## Easy to access!

- ✓ **3rd largest airport** in Poland
- ✓ **2,9 mln** passengers in **2022**
- ✓ Wrocław Airport is currently served by **10 scheduled airlines**
- ✓ **The city bus** runs to the center of Wrocław every 15 minutes and the entire route takes about **40-50 minutes**. Also, there is a possibility to reach the city center **by taxi**.
- ✓ Flight from Warsaw to Wrocław takes **50 minutes (approx. 75 EUR)**

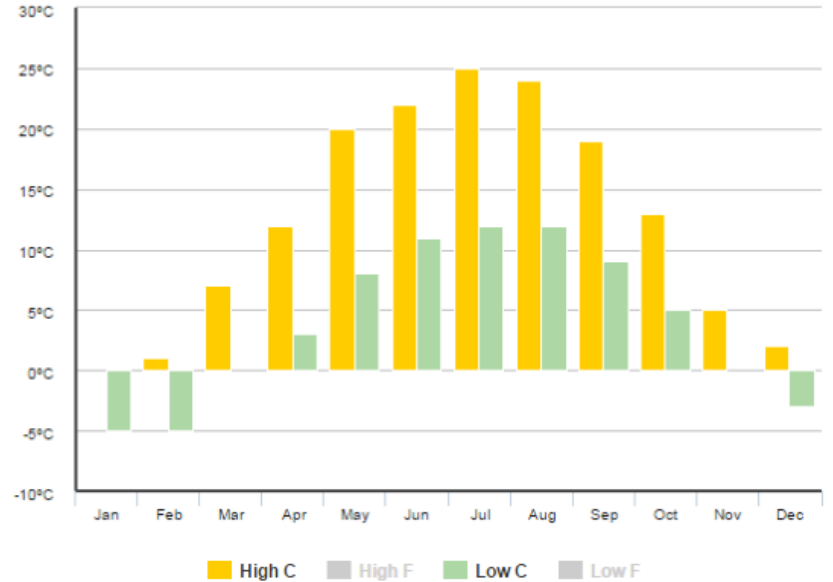


# Climate in Poland

---

**Poland's** climate can be described as a temperate one with relatively cold winters and warm summers, which is greatly influenced by oceanic air currents from the west, cold polar air from Scandinavia, as well as warmer, sub-tropical air from the south.

The greatest sunshine in summer is to be found on the Baltic coast, whilst in winter in the Carpathian Mountains. In the mountains, at any time of year, the climate is dependent on the altitude. In Wrocław, temperatures range from between 20 to 25°C during the summer months and 0°C to -5°C in winter.

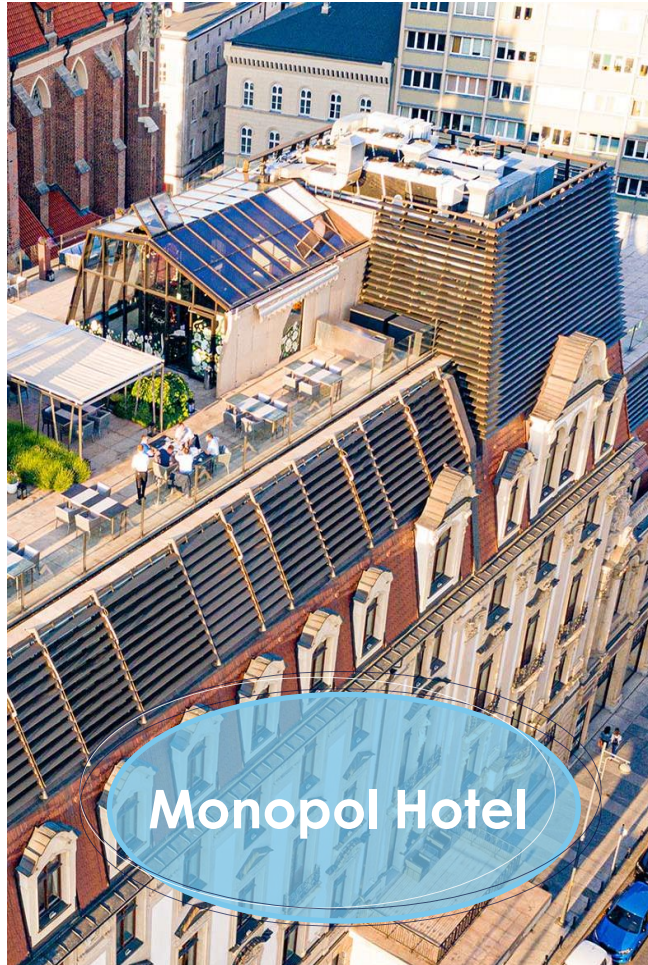

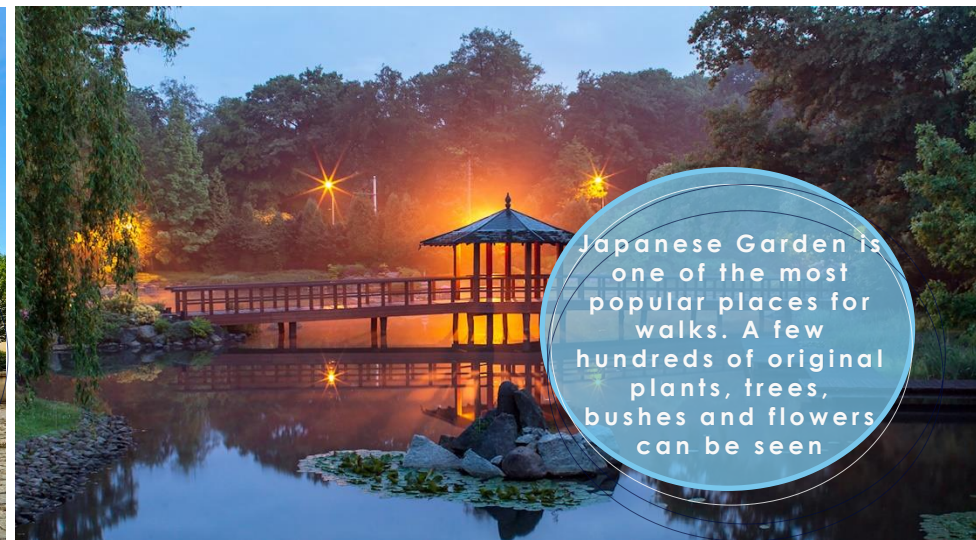
Centennial Hall is still one of the most important places in Wrocław hosting many cultural and sports events, was listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site



The Market Square in Wrocław is the third biggest in Poland! That qualifies it to be amongst the largest market squares in Europe as well

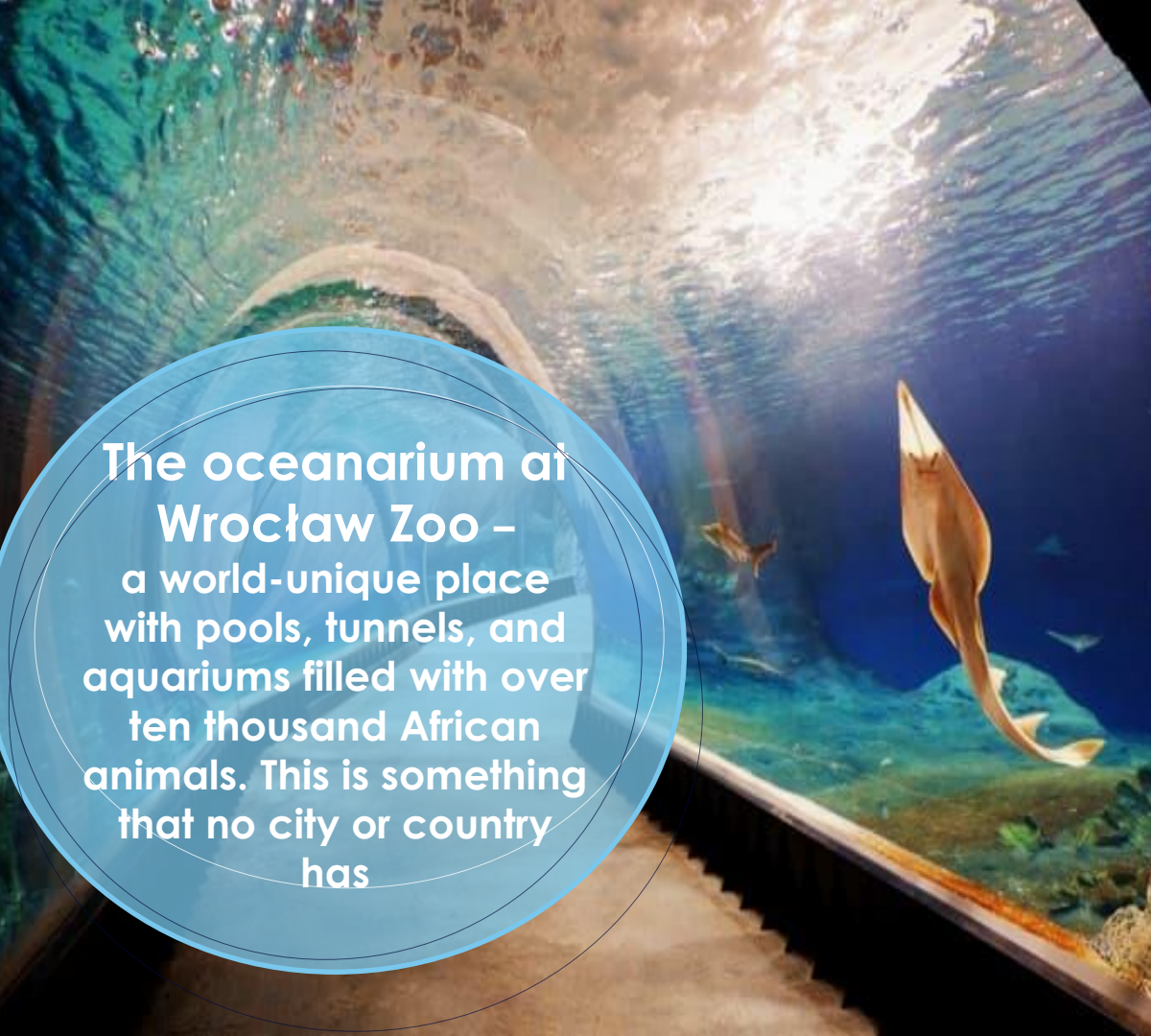


Beautiful Ostrów Tumski Island called Cathedral Island is where the city of Wrocław was born
