

Kentucky State Record Fish Application

Kentucky Department of Fish and Wildlife Resources

To qualify for consideration as a state record, the fish must have been legally caught in Kentucky waters by rod and reel or on a pole and line. Fish taken on commercial gear or by non-traditional methods (trotlines, gigging, snagging, bowfishing, etc.) are not eligible. Please see Page 2 for instructions on certifying your catch.

Information and Instructions

- 1. The angler has the right to release the fish and not submit it for a state record. If the angler chooses to submit the fish for a state record, the required transportation for positive identification will likely result in the death of the fish.
- 2. To be considered for a state record certification, the fish must be weighed on certified scales legal for trade in an unfrozen state. These scales may be found at supermarket meat centers, farm and feed stores, United Postal Service(UPS) or FedEx locations, and at KDFWR regional fisheries offices and fish hatcheries.
- **3.** Three witnesses, one of which must be the scale operator/owner, must fill out and sign part B of the application certifying that they have observed the declared weight.
- **4.** A new state record fish must have a minimum weight of 0.10 lbs and will only be recognized if the weight of the fish exceeds the present record weight by 0.10 lbs. or more. However, ties will be acknowledged.
- 5. It is the responsibility of the angler to contact and transport the fish to a KDFWR fisheries biologist or Wolf Creek National Fish Hatchery manager for positive identification (see KDFWR regional and hatchery offices below). The fish must be alive, fresh, or frozen until positive species identification can be established. Keep the fish intact (do not open or remove any part of the fish) until it can be identified by the biologist or hatchery manager. The weight of the fish may need to be further examined if suspicion arises. Note: A taxidermist can mount a fish that has been frozen after verification.
- **6.** Only two hybrid crosses, the Hybrid Striped Bass and Saugeye, will be considered for state record certification. Applicants must be willing to submit to the professional judgment of the certifying biologist as to the fish's hybrid status.
- **7.** Anglers of any age are eligible for state record fish submission, however 16 years of age and older must be licensed anglers and must provide their license number on the application.
