Estimates of Total Dead Is Guesswork

Disease Breaks Out in Flood-Swept City as the Rescue Work Proceeds; Estimate of Ten Millions Property Loss Stands; Military Commander Says Tragedy Can't Be Exaggerated

PUEBLO, Colo., June 5 .- Accoding to reports received by the sheriff's office tonight from Swallows, Colo., 16 miles west of here along the Arkansas river, a wall of water was rushing toward this city. Pueblo is momentarily expecting another catastrophe of greater magnitude than that of last Friday.

LAS ANIMAS, Colo., June 5 .- The flood in the Arkansas river from Pucblo to the Kansas state line is the greatest in 44 years. Water from cloudbursts in the Pueblo section hit La Junta at 3 p. m. yesterday with a twelve-foot crest. The water rose at the rate of three feet in ten minutes and spread to a three-mile width over the lowlands. La Junta is flooded to a depth of three feet and the city is without drinking water

or lights.
