Wash all produce carefully.



Control rats and clean up debris.



Cook food thoroughly.



Cover and inspect catchment tanks and containers.



Get rid of slugs and snails.

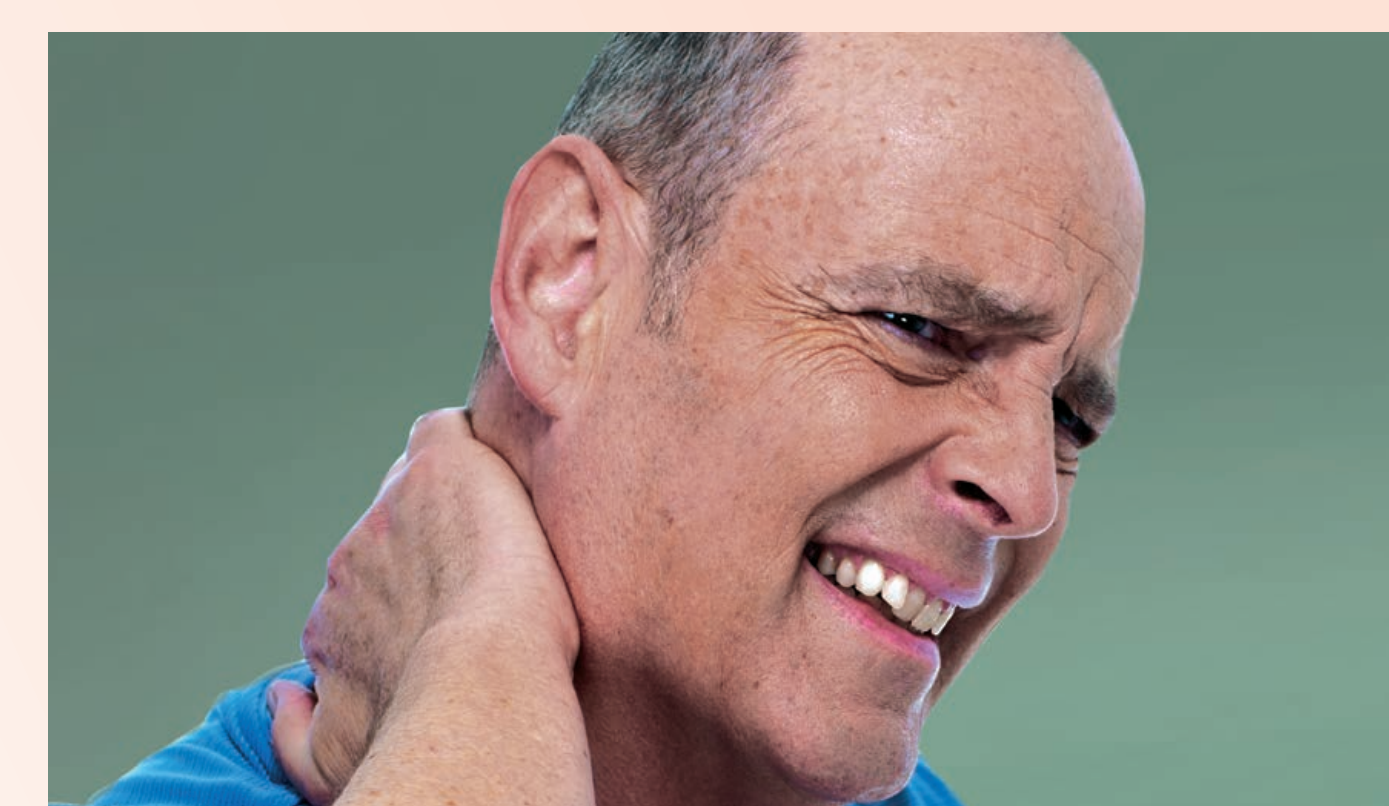
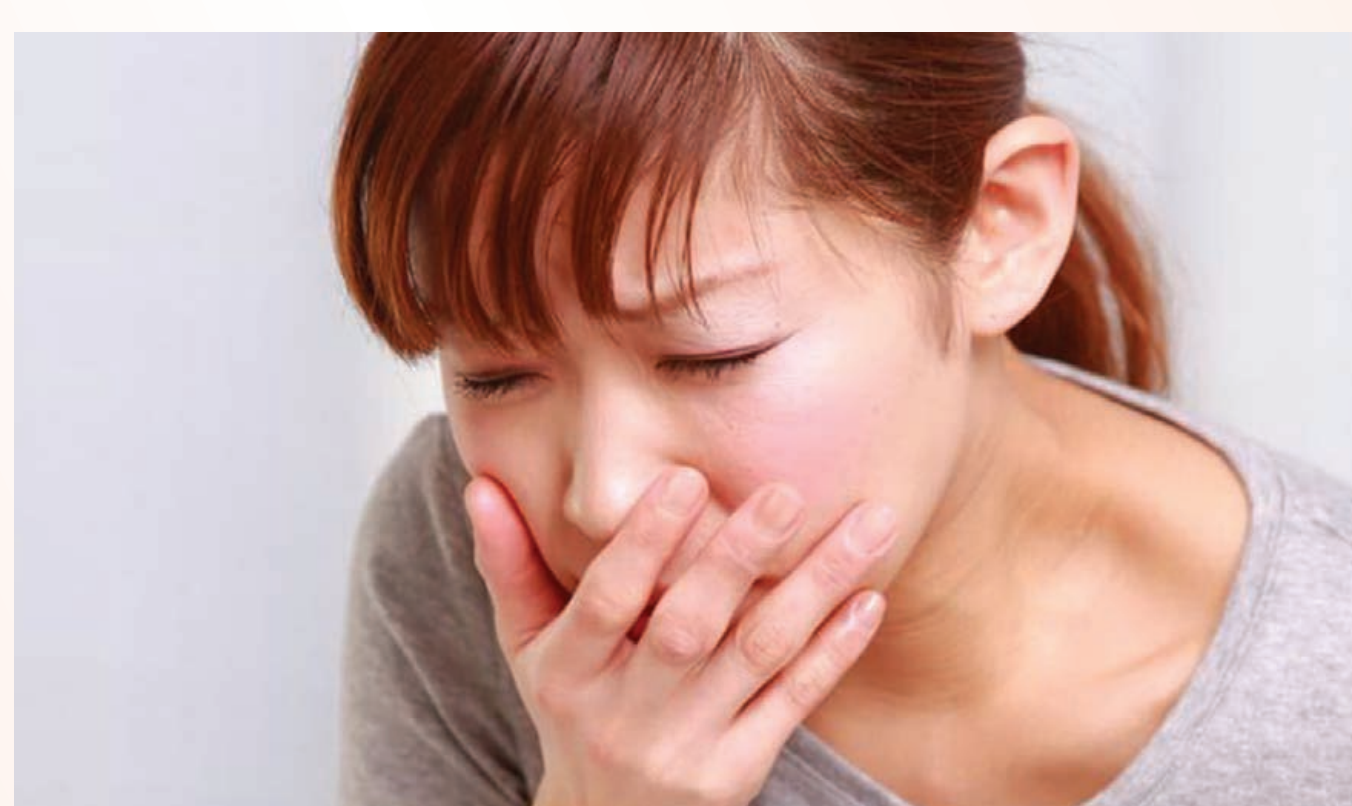
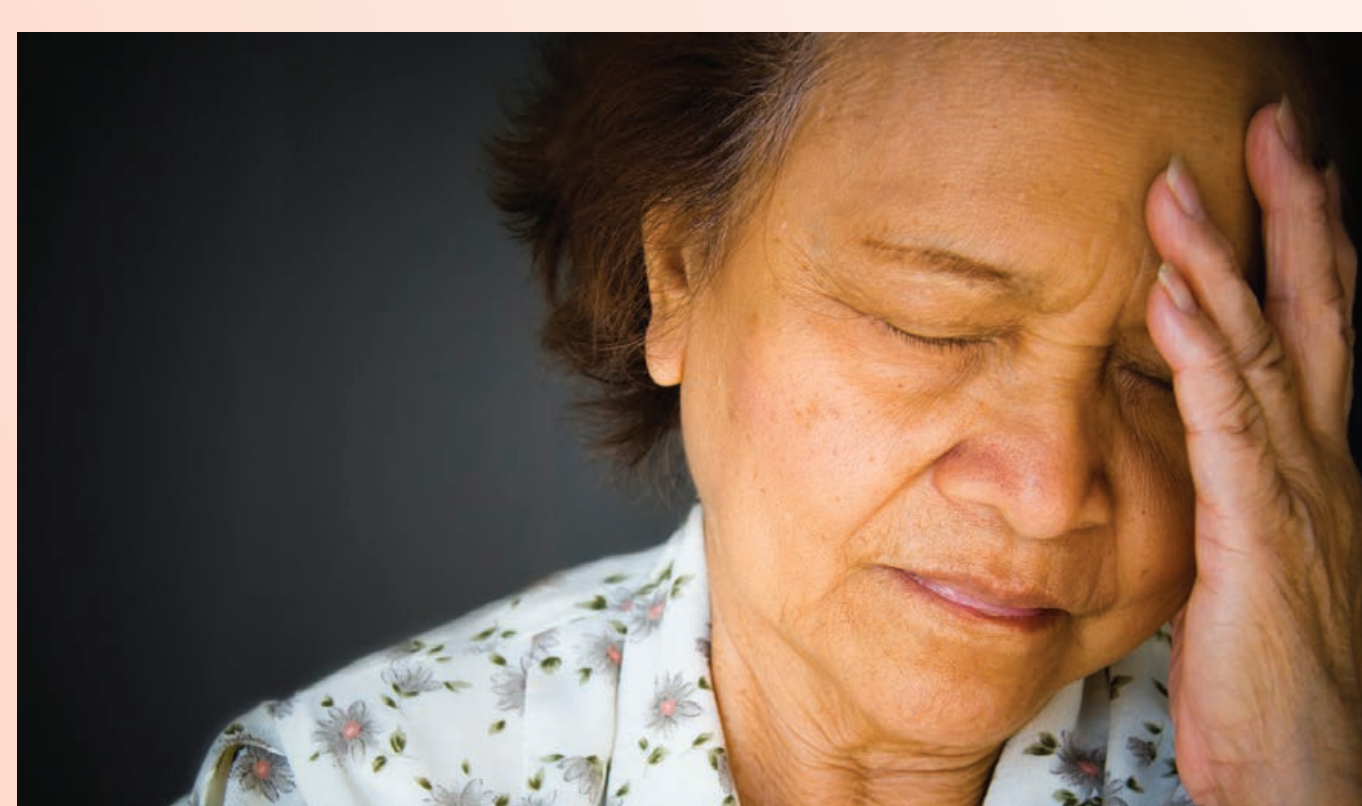


Keep children away from slugs and snails.
