Interested students must contact the Law Registrar and obtain approval of the Assistant Dean of Student Affairs to participate in and receive financial aid for a study away program.

How to Apply for Financial Aid for Study Away Programs

- File the Free Application for Federal Student Aid - FAFSA by March 2.
- Obtain permission to study at another ABA approved law school from the UC Davis Law Registrar and Assistant Dean of Student Affairs.
- Obtain a Visiting Student Agreement (VSA) on-line at <https://law.ucdavis.edu/financial-aid/special/study-away.html>. The Financial Aid Office at the host institution should complete and return the VSA to the UC Davis Law Financial Aid Office.
- Law students approved for study at another ABA approved law school or the King Hall Exchange Program are required to enroll in Direct Deposit at <https://afsapps.ucdavis.edu/direct-deposit/>.
- In order to defer education loan repayment, law students must have the **host school Registrar confirm enrollment for the study away period.**
- **Aid is scheduled to disburse ten (10) days before the start of each term at UC Davis School of Law. You must submit your completed VSA and proof of registration at the host school to UC Davis Law Financial Aid before the start of the term or disbursement of your financial aid may be delayed.**
