- (A2) Proposition No. 1 - EDUCATIONAL AND RELATED CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS BONDS**
Shall the Matanuska-Susitna Borough incur debt and issue general obligation bonds not to exceed Fifty-One Million Nine Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$51,950,000) for the purpose of paying a portion of the costs of planning, designing, acquiring property for, site preparation, constructing, installing, and equipping educational and related capital improvements within the borough, including but not limited to the following:

Bonds may not be issued to pay costs of a project unless the project has been authorized for debt service reimbursement by the State of Alaska. The approximate amount of taxes on \$100,000 of assessed real and personal property value (based on total 1995 assessed valuation) to retire 100 percent of the proposed debt for the projects above is \$217.10 per year, and to retire 20 percent of the proposed debt for the projects is \$65.13 per year.

The bonds shall be secured by a pledge of the full faith and credit of the borough. (Ordinance Serial No. 95-085)




