





6 hours

Required after every regular full-time term; must be degree applicable after first 2 years of enrollment; cannot use intercession credits



18 hours

Required after every year of enrollment using credits from regular academic terms; can use credits from intercession term; cannot use summer work



24 hours

Required before the start of the second year of enrollment; can use hours from the summers before and after the first year

Credit-hour Requirement (Quarter)



6 hours

Required after every regular full-time term; must be degree applicable after first 2 years of enrollment; cannot use intercession credits



27 hours

Required after every year of enrollment using credits from regular academic terms; can use credits from intercession term; cannot use summer school



36 hours

Required before the start of the second year of enrollment; can use hours from the summers before and after the first year

GPA Requirements

- Checked after every regular academic term beginning after the 1st year of enrollment.
- Calculated for each student-athlete against the GPA required for graduation per institutional policy.

Other Certification Issues to Consider

Additional certification issues that should be tracked include:



Good academic standing

Every student-athlete must be in good academic standing in order to compete.

Football Requirements



Football student-athletes must pass 9 semester or 8 quarter credit hours each fall term; must be degree-applicable after the first 2 years of enrollment; cannot use intercession credits.

Baseball Requirements



Baseball student-athletes must be academically eligible to compete in the fall term in order to be able to compete in the spring term.
