2023 SEASON CAT SCRATCHES

- Kentucky won the 2020 NCAA Volleyball National Championship with a 3-1 win over Texas, becoming the first SEC school to ever win the national title.
- 2023 is Craig Skinner's 19th season as the head coach at Kentucky. He is the second-longest tenured coach in the SEC (Mary Wise).
- UK has won six-straight SEC Championships.
- Azhani Tealer, Reagan Rutherford and Emma Grome are all returning AVCA All-Americans from 2022
- Kentucky has qualified for 18-straight NCAA Tournaments
- UK began the season ranked No. 10 in the AVCA Coaches' Poll.
- Kentucky won its lone exhibition match of the season vs. Western Kentucky, 3-1, on Aug. 17.
- Transferring into Kentucky is one player in 2023, Megan Wilson from Oklahoma
- Kentucky will be playing its entire home schedule at historic Rupp Arena in 2023 as Memorial Coliseum undergoes an \$82 million renovation and restoration. The expectation is that it will be completed for 2024.
- Kentucky liberos have won SEC Libero/Defensive Player of the Year in 11 of the last 13 years, including Eleanor Beavin in 2021.
- UK will play 10 matches on the ESPN family of networks in 2023, with two ESPN matches, including vs. Louisville and vs. Tennessee. Over 300K viewers watched UK's match vs. UoFL in 2022 on ESPN in the SEC's first-ever regular season match shown on ESPN.
- Emma Grome was named the SEC Player of the Year for the league in 2022, marking the fifth-straight year and fourth-different UK player to win it since 2018.
- Craig Skinner won the 2020-21 AVCA National Coach of the Year award, becoming the second UK head coach to win the award (Kathy DeBoer).

84 LUMBER VOLLEYBALL CLASSIC

Kentucky and Pitt, both schools who's media rights partner is JMI Sports, competed in the 2023 84 Lumber Volleyball Classic with an attendance-driven initiative. Kentucky got 5,048 fans into Rupp Arena on Friday, September 1, the fifth-largest crowd in Kentucky Volleyball history. Pittsburgh drew 3,867 fans for their home match of the classic on Sept. 3.

NEW LOOK ON THE BENCH

After Anders Nelson accepted the head coaching job at Vanderbilt following 12 years at UK, Craig Skinner was in the market for an associate head coach for the first time in 12 years. After a national and international search, Skinner hired Ben Josephson, who was a national champion head coach for men's college volleyball. Josephson will take over the tactical role that Nelson played on the staff for 2023.

Additionally, with the NCAA allowing a fourth full-time assistant coach beginning in 2023, Skinner went to the alumna base and added in national champion and former AVCA National Player of the Year, Madison Lilley. Lilley will work specifically with the setters on a day-to-day basis.

RANKING THE RANKED

Kentucky has been ranked inside of the top-25 of the American Volleyball Coaches' Association Top-25 poll in 109 consecutive weeks. This is a program record for UK that spans seven complete seasons. The

FULL STRENGTH ON ROCKY TOP

Kentucky's starting lineup was at full strength for the first time since Sept. 17 on Oct. 15 when it went to No. 10 Tennessee and swept the Lady Vols on Rocky Top. The Wildcats were able to return the favor, after UT swept UK in Lexington with UK missing Reagan Rutherford on SEC opening weekend, Sept. 24.

ABOVE WATER

UK is above the .500 mark for the first time all season, now sitting at 8-7.

ELEANOR BEAVIN GETS TO EB1K

Eleanor Beavin recorded her 1,000th-career dig on Oct. 15 in UK's 3-0 win at #10 Tennessee. Beavin becomes the 12th person all-time at Kentucky to record 1,000 career digs. She will be honored prematch against Mississippi State with a game ball presented by UK head coach Craig Skinner.

SEC AWARDS HAUL

Kentucky won four SEC weekly awards, its largest haul of the season, on Oct. 17. Emma Grome was named the SEC Player of the Week and Setter of the Week, with Elise Goetzinger winning her first-ever career award, SEC Offensive Player of the Week and Brooklyn DeLeye winning her second-straight SEC Freshman of the Week.

TEALER TAKING THE VICTORY LAP

Azhani Tealer will become the first-ever fifth-year player in Kentucky Volleyball history, as she has elected to use her COVID year of eligibility with UK this season after competing in 2019, 2020-21, 2021 and 2022.

KENTUCKY PICKED TO WIN SEC FOR 2023

The Kentucky Volleyball team was picked by the Southeastern Conference head coaches to win the league title for a sixth year in a row. Kentucky won 10 of 13 first-place votes with Florida receiving two and Tennessee garnering one.

UNUSUAL START

Kentucky was four games under .500 for the first time since 2004. Craig Skinner had never been four games or more under the .500 mark as the head coach of the Kentucky Volleyball program until UK was 3-7 on the year. He took over in 2005.

VIEW FROM THE TOP

Dating back to UK's 3-2 win in Gainesville against Florida on November 17, 2019, the Kentucky Volleyball team had either been in sole possession of the SEC lead or tied for the lead in the volleyball standings loss column for 1,042 consecutive days until the five-set loss vs. LSU on Sept. 24, 2022.

That lasted a total of 12 days before UK pulled even with Auburn and Florida on Sept. 29.

All told - Kentucky has held first place solo or shared for 1,394 of the last 1,430 calendar days.

The Kentucky Volleyball team swept South Carolina 3-0 (25-21, 29-27, 25-16) inside Memorial Coliseum to claim its sixth-straight Southeastern Conference volleyball championship, finishing the 2022 SEC season with a 15-3 record in league matches.

DELEYE NOT PLAYING LIKE A FRESHMAN

Kentucky's Brooklyn DeLeye recorded 25 kills in a five-set win at Georgia and also had 25 kills in the next match at Alabama on Sunday. She becomes the first freshman to have 20+ kills in back-to-back matches since Leah Edmond did it in 2016. Edmond went on to become UK's first-ever four-time AVCA All-American.

RPI = SOS

Kentucky was slotted at No. 29 in the second release of the NCAA's Volleyball RPI. UK has played five matches against top-25 RPI teams and eight of its 10 matches against the RPI top-50. UK has the No. 2 strength of schedule nationally.

AWARD SEASON IS BACK

The Southeastern Conference announced Oct. 9 that Brooklyn DeLeye is the SEC Offensive Player of the Week, Emma Grome is the SEC Setter of the Week and Eleanor Beavin is the SEC Defensive Player of the Week. It is the first time this season UK has had three weekly award winners.

DELEYE REACHING FOR HISTORY

Outside hitter Brooklyn DeLeye ran her streak of consecutive matches with 10+ kills to four as she led Kentucky with 18 kills Friday night and 19 kills Sunday afternoon. She averaged 4.63 kills per set and with her third-straight double-double vs. Mizzou, became UK's first freshman to have three-straight double-doubles since AVCA National Player of the Year Madison Lilley did it in 2017. DeLeye also had an ace in both matches on the week and was the leading point-scorer for both teams in both matches played this weekend. In serve receive, DeLeye was targeted a total of 48 times, and committed zero reception errors.

LITTLE MISS 3,000

Emma Grome recorded her 3,000th-career assist, becoming the eighth player all-time at UK to achieve that mark with her first assist vs. Mizzou on Oct. 6. She was honored pre-match on Oct. 8 vs. Ole Miss with a ball presentation from head coach Craig Skinner.

ROAD STREAK SNAPPED

Dating back to 2017, Kentucky had not lost back-to-back road matches until it dropped matches to Pitt and Purdue in 2023. UK did beat Houston before beating Purdue, but the Houston match was neutral site.

DELEYE AND GROME WIN UK'S FIRST SEC WEEKLY HONORS

Brooklyn DeLeye was named the SEC Player of the Week and SEC Offensive Player of the Week on Oct. 2. Additionally, Emma Grome was named the SEC's Setter of the Week. DeLeye had a career-high in kills in back-to-back matches, as she had 25 terminations vs. Georgia in a five setter Friday night, before backing that up with a 25-kill performance at Alabama in four Sunday. Grome set a new season high Sunday afternoon with 58 assists as No. 23 Kentucky beat Alabama. On the weekend, Grome averaged 12.33 assists per set, with 53 assists recorded Friday in a five-set win over Georgia and backing that up with the 58 assists vs. Bama.

FOUR WILDCATS ON PRESEASON ALL-SEC TEAM

The SEC All-Preseason Team was comprised of 15 players, with four Wildcats being named to the team in Eleanor Beavin, Emma Grome, Reagan Rutherford and Azhani Tealer.

EMMA GROME WINS 2022 SEC PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Kentucky Volleyball player Emma Grome was named the Southeastern Conference's Player of the Year in 2022 as UK won the award for the fifth-straight season as Grome joins Leah Edmond (2018, 2019), Madison Lilley (2020) and Alli Stumler (2021) in the past half decade to win the award for the Wildcats.

Since being tabbed Kentucky's head coach in December 2004, Craig Skinner has rejuvenated the Kentucky volleyball program into national prominence and is the program's all-time winningest head coach. He will enter his 19th season in 2023.

He reached the pinnacle of the sport in April of 2021, winning the 2020 NCAA National Championship at the CHI Health Center in Omaha, Nebraska. In doing so, he became the head coach of the first volleyball team in Southeastern Conference history to win a national championship. He was named the AVCA's National Coach of the Year in 2020-21.

Skinner has directed the Wildcats to 18 consecutive NCAA Tournaments - a feat only nine other schools in the nation have achieved. That run includes eight Sweet Sixteen appearances since 2009, two Elite Eight appearances, the 2020 NCAA Final Four and back-to-back-to-back-to-back-to-back SEC titles in 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020-21 and 2021. Furthermore, the Wildcats have captured 17 or more victories in all 18 seasons under Skinner's direction, including tallying 20 or more wins in 14 of the last 16 seasons.

MEMORIAL COLISEUM

Playing in the friendly confines of Memorial Coliseum is a tremendous home-court advantage for the Kentucky volleyball team, which plays all of its matches in the historic facility.

The Wildcats have compiled a 492-171 record, good for a .745 winning percentage in their 40th season in the facility. In the last 18 seasons under Coach Skinner, Kentucky is an astounding 234-52 (.856) at home.

It played host to NCAA Regionals in 2011, 2013, 2015 and 2017. Memorial also currently serves as the home court for the UK women's basketball and gymnastics teams. The storied gymnasium also housed some of the greatest moments in UK men's basketball history as its home for 26 seasons from 1950 to 1976.

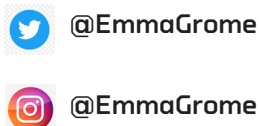

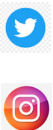
