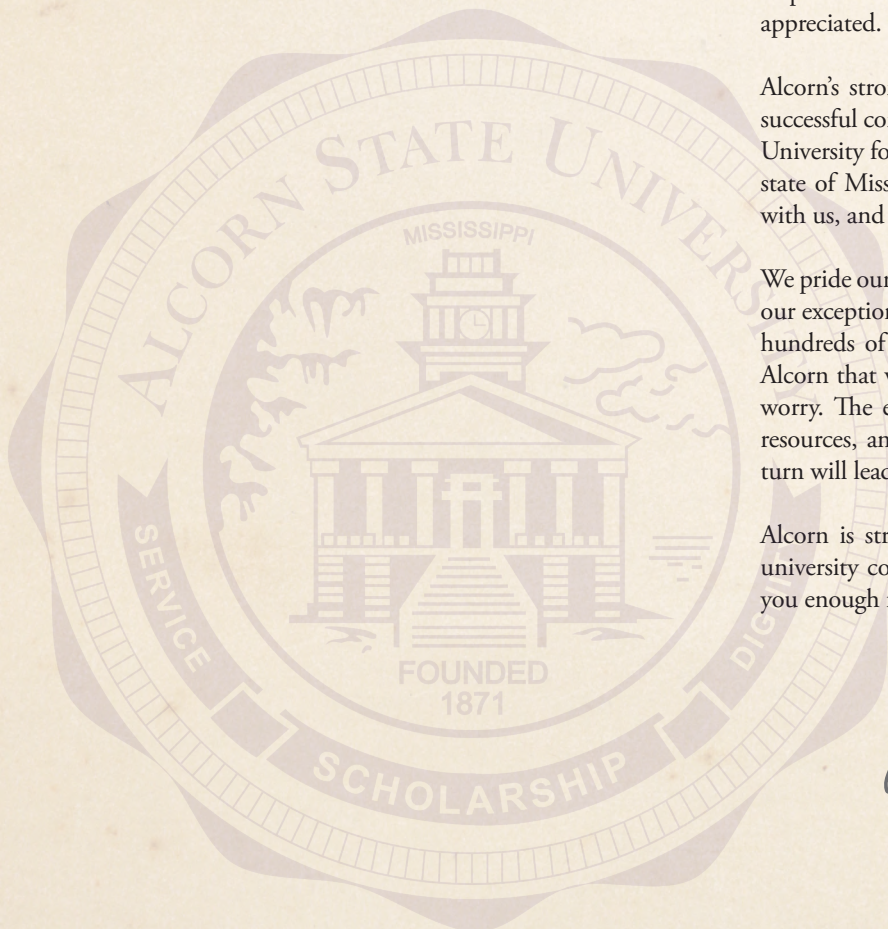

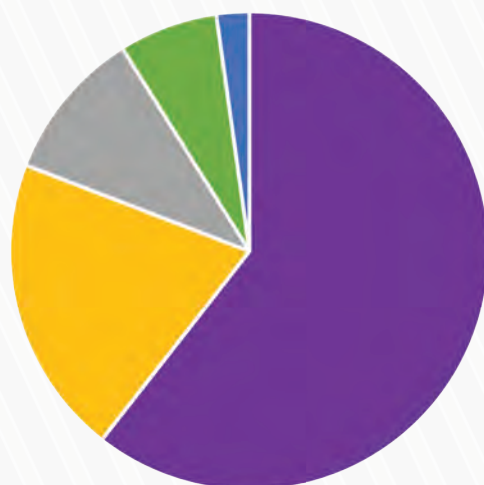

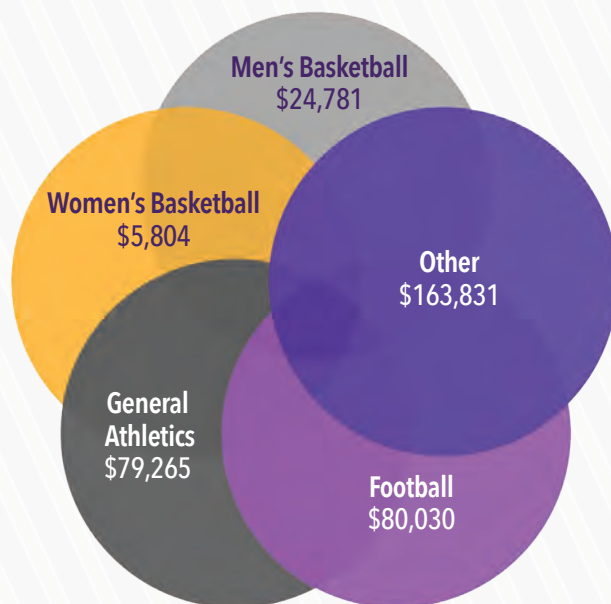

The Foundation formed in 1995 and has awarded \$144 million in grants through November 2016.

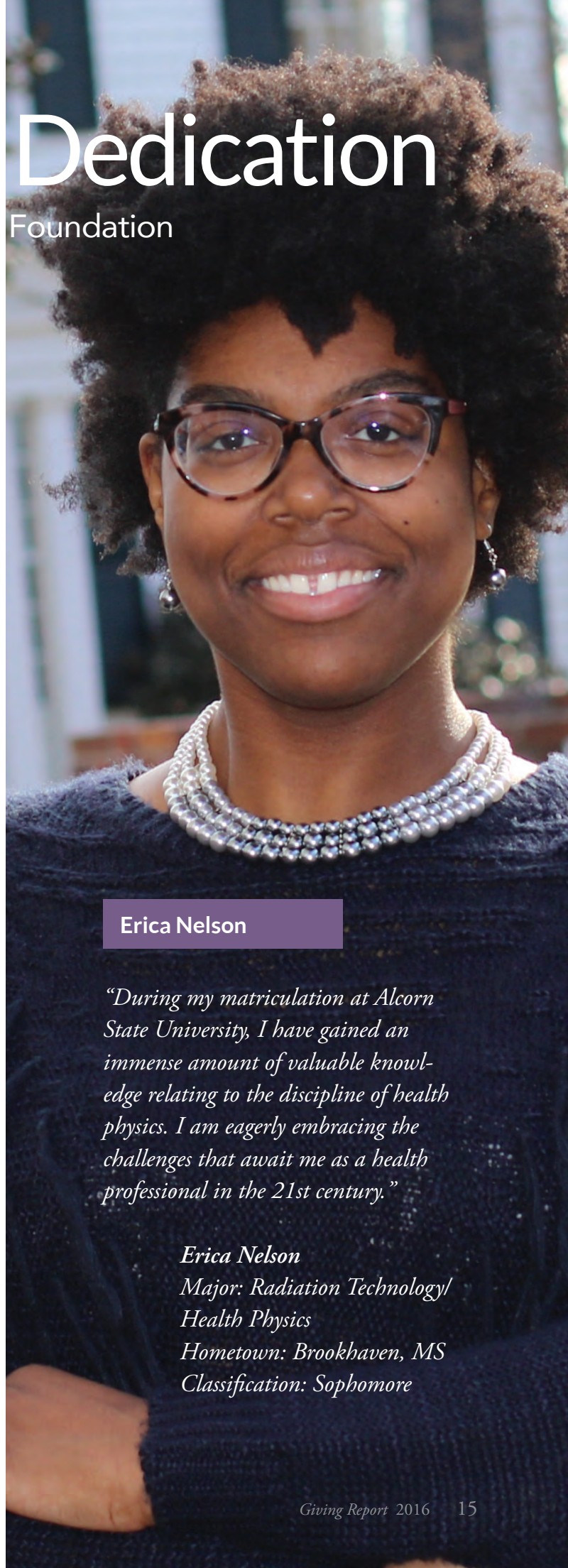
For Malik East, achieving his dreams of excelling in the world of computer engineering seems more attainable now that he's a Robert M. Hearin Support Foundation scholar.

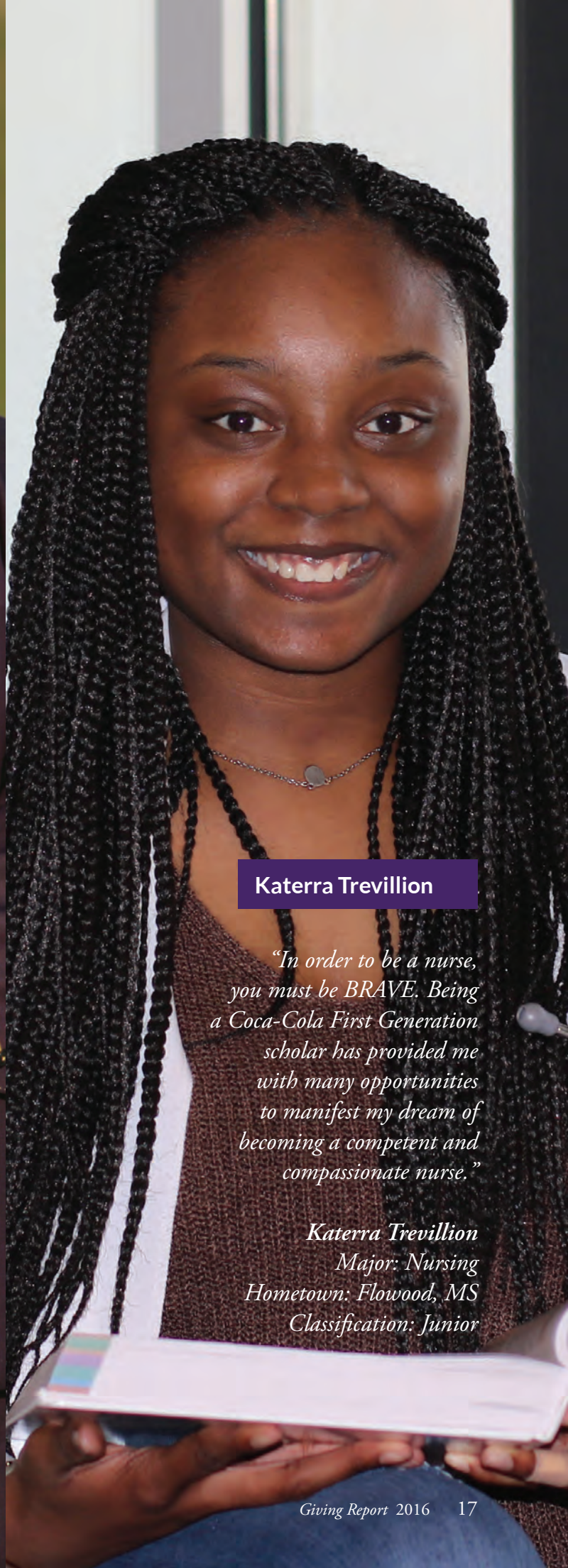

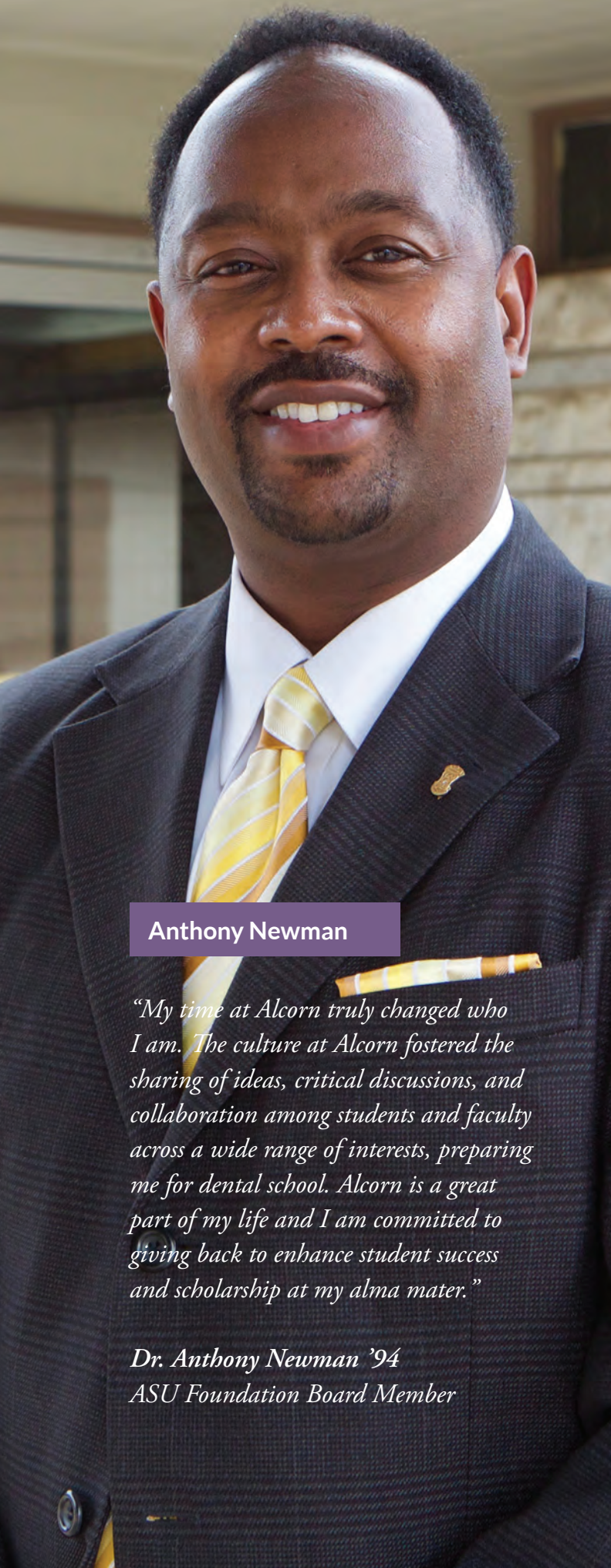

Intellectual Renewal grants inspire recipients to dream big

The pursuit of educational and professional development is at the forefront of every Alcornite's agenda. Here at Alcorn State University, numerous financial awards are presented to our esteemed faculty, staff and students that would help lead them to prosperity on their respective journeys.

The ASU Foundation, Inc. offers Intellectual Renewal grants to assist faculty, staff and students with expenses as they seek academic and professional development opportunities. In 2016, the Foundation awarded more than \$26,000 in Intellectual Renewal grants to assist with research, attend and present at conferences, and strengthen their knowledge bases.

Opportunities such as the Intellectual Renewal grant inspire others to dream big, which was the case for graduate student Josephine Tepeh. After earning the grant, Tepeh experienced for herself the benefits of becoming a grant recipient.

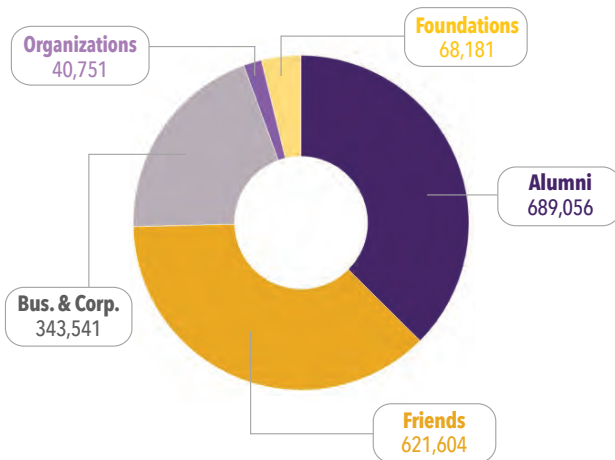

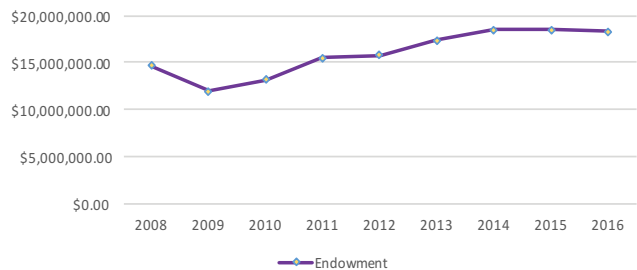
