



AmeriCorps Child Care Assistance: Income Eligibility

Use the chart below to determine if you qualify for the child care benefit program based on income. Members must serve in a full-time capacity. Educator Corps or Professional Corps members are not eligible. Please note, the income requirements are subject to change without warning.

Maximum monthly income includes the following:

- Wages/salaries/tips received for employment for member, spouse, and other household members
- Public benefits including SNAP, housing assistance, and any other assistance from the state/county
- Unemployment benefits for the member, spouse, or other household members
- Social Security benefits
- Disability income
- Worker's compensation
- Veteran's benefits
- Child Support
- Alimony
- Rental Income
- Interest & dividend income

The AmeriCorps living allowance is not calculated into the monthly income.
