- **Now Open! ANTHC Behavioral Health Wellness Clinic (BHWC)**

Offering services online and by phone via telemedicine, the ANTHC Behavioral Health Wellness Clinic is a primary behavioral health clinic designed to meet the patient's everyday behavioral health needs.

The BHWC serves Alaska Native and American Indian individuals and families throughout the state of Alaska. Clients will be able to begin care quickly and with minimal paperwork. All services are being provided through telehealth (phone and video), so individuals from across Alaska can access care.

- **Current BHWC telehealth services include:**

- Substance use assessments
- Mental health assessments
- Individual counseling
- Group counseling
- Health behavior coaching
- Referral support

More behavioral health services will continue to be added in the future.
