This hands-on virtual training is designed to ensure providers and staff are confident and proficient in using telemedicine carts and equipment to be able to deliver high-quality remote care.

Who should attend: Providers, nurses, community health aides, and support staff using **new NTIA telemedicine carts and/or peripheral devices:** BioLogic Tympanometry/Audiometry/DPOAE, Global Med Total Exam 3, JedMed LED 50 HD II, Midmark Digital ECG

What you'll learn: How to set up and operate telemedicine carts and peripheral devices effectively. Best practices for optimizing audio, video and peripheral tools. Troubleshooting tips and technical support resources.

Why attend: Learn how to increase access to care using telemedicine services, provide faster care for patients (reduce or expedite travel), and if you are a CHAP, you are eligible to receive CEU!

What you need: New NTIA telemedicine cart and/or peripheral devices, network access to log-in to the cart, AFHCAN user account (if applicable), and ability to join Zoom training session (internet access, webcam, microphone and speaker).
