The National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) received your letter dated December 16, 2020, regarding the loss of United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) records. Your letter indicates that the Rural Development Business Center, in Salt Lake City, Utah, had a water main break on September 20, 2020 that destroyed certain agency records.

We understand that 15 loan application files were lost and 14 additional files are being reconstructed. We are satisfied with the safeguards established to prevent further loss, however, in order to make our final determination on this case, we need the disposition authority number(s) that pertain to the records that were destroyed. The National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) received your updated final report on February 1, 2021, regarding a water main break on September 20, 2020 at the Rural Development Business Center in Salt Lake City, Utah that damaged and destroyed certain agency records.

We understand that the 15 loan application files that were prematurely destroyed were temporary records, covered under approved records schedule DAA-0572-2017-0004. We also understand that the Rural Development Business Center was able to successfully reconstruct 14 other loan application files and have established new protocols and training to prevent any future loss of records.

Based on the information that you provided, the reporting requirements of 36 CFR 1230.14(a) have been met and NARA considers this matter closed.
