The Coast Guard's portfolio of aviation acquisition programs will recapitalize the service's fixed- and rotary-wing aircraft fleets by delivering new and upgraded platforms – including the HC-144, HC-130J, MH-65E and MH-60T programs provide improved mission equipment and advanced operational capabilities to Coast Guard aircrews. Working closely with requirements sponsors and technical authorities, the Service is completing service life extension and upgrade work to maximize our aviation asset capabilities and longevity while minimizing lifecycle total ownership costs.



This vessel will provide a platform capable of projecting U.S. sovereignty and influence while conducting Coast Guard statutory missions in the high latitudes.


