### EXAMPLE PROJECT

In FY2021, EDA awarded **\$12,800,000 in Economic Adjustment Assistance - FY2018 Disaster Supplemental funds to support the construction of a five-story building on the former Coast Guard Pier, Naval Station Roosevelt Roads** to house the Marine Business, Research and Innovation Research Center (MBRIC) in San Juan County, Puerto Rico. The MBRIC will serve as the central hub to access specialized equipment and provide technical assistance to multiple partners to support ocean dependent and ag-business in the development of new products and service for exporting.
