Section C – Transition Status

Required field for transition reporting

KDE works with KYStats to collect data on the following graduates (beginning with cohort 2020):

- Those that have enrolled in college in Kentucky;
- Those that enter directly into the workforce;
- Or a combination thereof.

At the school level you only need to populate the “Transition Status” dropdown in the Graduation tab in Infinite Campus for those students that do not fall into one of those three categories. Starting with cohort 2020, schools are only required to follow up and populate the “Transition Status” dropdown in Infinite Campus for the following graduates:

- those that plan to enroll in college outside of Kentucky;
- those that plan to enter military/community/Peace Corps service;
- those that plan to enroll in a proprietary technical school;
- those that are continuing high school education (Grade 14 students);
- and those students from the cohort that are deceased.

The work to be done on the front end is that schools will need to identify graduates that fall into those categories (that cannot be collected by KYStats) before students leave high school. It is suggested that schools develop a simple survey during the spring semester of the cohort’s senior year to determine each graduate’s immediate plan after high school and the best way to contact each graduate after graduation. The survey of students will be a bit of work but will significantly lessen the amount of work on the back end for school personnel as most students statewide either enroll in college in Kentucky, enter directly into the workforce or a combination thereof.

One question that arose in the development of the plan was whether KYStats would be able to provide schools a list of students they collect before schools enter data into the “Transition Status” dropdown. Unfortunately, no, that is not possible as that would violate the KYStats confidentiality clause. KYStats will only be providing aggregate data to KDE (the number of your graduates enrolled in college in Kentucky, number of your graduates in the workforce and number of your graduates that are a combination of college/work). We understand that this may result in a few students “slipping through the cracks” (for example, if a student tells you in your survey that she is going to attend college and she does not actually enroll in college but instead enlists in the military without your knowledge – this student would “fall through the cracks” as you would not be following up with her and KYStats cannot collect military data – we would officially report this student as “Unknown”).

Finally, there is a new role in the Person Role Manager system – Transition to Adult Life Contact. If your district/school has not yet assigned this role, you may want your Web Apps Admin Point of Contact (WAAPOC) to do so at their earliest convenience. In the future, all communications regarding transition will be sent primarily to this role list.

Section D – State Seal Information

Tool Search: Graduation

The purpose of the State Seal field is to recognize high school graduates who attained a high level of proficiency in one or more content areas. Identifying students as earning a New State Seal is a district decision and should be board approved. KDE’s Office of Teaching and Learning published guidelines for establishing a [Seal of Biliteracy](#) and a [Seal of Arts Excellence](#).

Districts may choose how to recognize their State Seal students. Student commendations may include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Indication of a State Seal on transcript/e-transcript;
- Special seal on the diploma;
- Graduation cord or sash for the ceremony;
- Senior Night award or certificate; and/or
- Verbal or written recognition in the graduation program or ceremony.

Districts that choose to recognize their State Seal students on their local transcripts can use the State Seal Information fields.
