About

The *ILP Data* includes student level data regarding the student’s Individualized Learning Plan. The **Individual Learning Plan (ILP)** has been a requirement for all Rhode Island students in grades 6-12 since 2005 when it was incorporated into the state’s Secondary School and Graduation Requirement Regulations. ILPs are a student-directed planning and monitoring tool that customizes learning opportunities throughout students’ secondary school experience, broadens their perspectives, and supports attainment of goals. The ILP documents students’ interests, needs, supports, course selections (including access to college level programming), transition placements and other learning experiences both in and out of school. This information produces a thoughtful program of study leading to proficiency for graduation and postsecondary experiences. A meaningful ILP for all Rhode Island students:

- Begins no later than entry into sixth grade and is maintained through 12th grade.
- Is revisited at least twice each school year, and at key transition periods for students.
- Helps students identify and meet their goals in three domains: academic, career and personal/ social.
- Coordinates with other support plans as appropriate. For example, individualized education programs (IEPs), Section 504 plans, Personal Literacy Plans, etc.

Both the Secondary School Regulations and the state's [PrepareRI state action plan for career readiness](#) identifies the ILP as the backbone of personalization and relevance of a student's education. All middle and high schools were required to adopt an ILP system from the state-vetted menu or develop their own ILP system and curriculum model.

Requirements

ILP data submission to RIDE from LEAs began in SY2021-22. *ILP* must be submitted to RIDE on a quarterly basis.

Changes for 2024-25 School Year

There are no changes for the 2024-25 school year.

Data Pull Dates

ILP data should be pulled from ILP web platforms and submitted to RIDE on the following dates:

- Q1: November 15, 2024, submit to RIDE by December 4, 2024
- Q2: February 14, 2025, submit to RIDE by March 7, 2025
- Q3: April 25, 2025, submit to RIDE by May 9, 2025
- Q4: June 7, 2025, submit to RIDE by June 14, 2025

Submission Process

ILP data can be submitted through eRIDE (www.eride.ri.gov) using the Enrollment Census application or through the Automated Data Transfer (ADT) agent. ILP is a submission type within the Enrollment Census application.

Validations

DISTCODE – This field must be a valid LEA in the RIDE master directory and must also be the district associated with the user that is submitting the data.

SCHCODE – This field must be a valid school in the RIDE master directory and must also be a school within the *DISTCODE*.

SASID – This field must be a valid *SASID* in the RIDE student master directory.

GRADE – Student grade must fall within the grade range for the school.
