Subject of Review: Taiwan is an Asian market with high-income consumers and limited production of farm products. While it has been a leading market for U.S. agricultural exports, U.S. agricultural products have been losing market share in Taiwan. The United States has taken early steps toward what might become a trade agreement with Taiwan that could improve its position in Taiwan's agricultural market. This study identifies competitive factors affecting U.S. market share for Taiwan's leading agricultural imports and assesses the prospects for reversing the decline in U.S. market share through a free trade agreement that reduced tariffs on key U.S. agricultural goods.
