Rággočearru

- o 2014 Positive story in local newspaper:
 - «The first non-controversial windmill park now operating»
- 2019 Controvery over evaluation report
- o 2020: 49% of shares sold to foreign interests
- New Plans evolving



Climate Change Impacts

- Winter: fluctations around zero
- Unsecure ice
- Longer growing season
- Heavy snowfalls

Fovsen-Njaarke Case

- o Reindeer Herders / environmentalist opposing the wind industry
- Roan and Storheia wind power plants,
 151 turbines, in operation since
 2019/20
- O Supreme Court ruling October 2021: construction violets Sámi reindeer herders' right to enjoy their cuture.
