**Pablo Picasso** (/*pɪˈkaʊsoʊ*, -kəsou/;<sup>[2]</sup> Spanish: [paˈβlo piˈkaso]; 25 October 1881 – 8 April 1973) was a Spanish painter, sculptor, printmaker, ceramicist, stage designer, poet and playwright who spent most of his adult life in France. Regarded as one of the most influential artists of the 20th century, he is known for co-founding the Cubist movement, the invention of constructed sculpture,<sup>[3][4]</sup> the co-invention of collage, and for the wide variety of styles that he helped develop and explore. Among his most famous works are the proto-Cubist *Les Demoiselles d'Avignon* (1907), and *Guernica* (1937), a dramatic portrayal of the bombing of Guernica by the German and Italian airforces.

Picasso demonstrated extraordinary artistic talent in his early years, painting in a naturalistic manner through his childhood and adolescence. During the first decade of the 20th century, his style changed as he experimented with different theories, techniques, and ideas. After 1906, the Fauvist work of the slightly older artist [Henri Matisse](#) motivated Picasso to explore more radical styles, beginning a fruitful rivalry between the two artists, who subsequently were often paired by critics as the leaders of modern art.<sup>[5][6][7][8]</sup>

Picasso's work is often categorized into periods. While the names of many of his later periods are debated, the most commonly accepted periods in his work are the [Blue Period](#) (1901–1904), the [Rose Period](#) (1904–1906), the [African-influenced Period](#) (1907–1909), Analytic Cubism (1909–1912), and Synthetic Cubism (1912–1919), also referred to as the [Crystal period](#). Much of Picasso's work of the late 1910s and early 1920s is in a [neoclassical](#) style, and his work in the mid-1920s often has characteristics of [Surrealism](#). His later work often combines elements of his earlier styles.

Exceptionally prolific throughout the course of his long life, Picasso achieved universal renown and immense fortune for his revolutionary artistic accomplishments, and became one of the best-known figures in 20th-century art.







ג'ברא מנדייל (1936 – פברואר 2006) היה צלם ישראלי, מראשמי צלמי הפרסום והאופה בישראל, ז"ר התאחדות הצלמים, מורה לצלמים, מייסד סטודיו ג'ברא.

**ביוגרפיה** [עריכה קוד מקור | עריכה]  
ג'ברא מנדייל נולד בשנת 1936 בבלגראד למשפחה נילימית. סבו ג'ברא קונגפי, אבי אמו, היה צלם החצר של מלך יוגוסלביה, ואביו, משה, היה צלם ידוע של סטודיו לצלים במ-60, לשם עקרה המשפחה. עם תחילת הכיבוש הנאצי פונתה המשפחה מיווגסלביה, כאשר כישרין הצילום של אב המשפחה ונויעתו צילמה אותו פעמיים אחר פעם. לאחר גלגולים רבים נמלטה המשפחה לאלבניה, שם הושתורו עד סוף המלחמה על ידי רפייק ולוי, אח מ蒿סיטניטים של האב, בביתו בהרים. על זאת זהה הוא ומשפחתו בתואר חסידי אומות העולם.

לאחר המלחמה חזרה משפחת מנדייל ליווגסלביה, ובשנת 1949 עלויה לישראל. המשפחה השתקעה בחיפה, שם פתחה את **סטודיו תלפיות**. למשך קשיי הקוליטה בארץ, התערה ג'ברא ב/categories בחברת בי גלי, הצטרף לתנועת הצופים, הדיר בה, והתגייס לנח"ל כשאר חברי. השתתף במלחמות סיני, חזק'ר [קוקבו] – תל קצ'ר, ולאחר מכן כופה ערב.

למרות שלא תכנן לבו כצלם מכל רוח אנגלי, מצא את עצמו כבעל ערך יידי התפתחות החדשנות של עולם הצילום בחו"ל. הוא סיים לימודי תואר ראשון באנגליה ועמד בבחינות הגמר הקפדניות של איגוד צלמיים המקביעים שם. אחד מצלמיינו צכה בפרס בערבה בה חשו כבודות של בוגר ספר צילום מכל רוח אנגלי. עם סיום לימודיו עבר אצל פטרון והוא רכש פיסוי רב. במלחין בקיור בארכ' נישא לנעמי, חיכתו לשעבר, נבי הוגו חזו לאנגנליה ושהה בה עד תום הלימודים והעבדה.

ג'ברא שה לישראלי שבת 1962 וזכה את **סטודיו ג'ברא** צילומי רופאות, אופנה וטשנויות, ברבות העדודה 24 בימי אבב. כמו כן כל הלימוד האරורים היו צלמי "פוטו", דוגמתת בגין, שאליטם הכלול – אירוחים, חתונות וגם – פורטנאות צילומי אופנה מוד' פעם. ג'ברא יצר למשה את הביקושים לצלמים ואיסוציאטס כדי שילוחם המהוירם יתאפשר. הוא היה שותף מלא בקביעת הקונספט, בסטיילינג, בליהוק, ובבחירה הצלמים. הוא הבהיר את תחומי צילום הפרסום משב רוח רענן וחדשי המעלם הגדול. בין ליקוטו נאם משרדי הפרסום והודיל, אל-על, משרד המשלה, הבנקים הדגולים, מפעלי הפיס, אמכוון, תדייאן ועוד. הוא צילם את מלות הופיע והודיעים במשך שנים 60-70 לשער לאשה ואות זומרם להעיפוי תקהלים של הר ארץ. הוא עבר עם בכרי האופאים: פני לוייטסדורף במנצ'סטר, דודן אובודין, גוטפק, דיזה ואטה.

בשנת 1969 ייסד את איגוד הישראלי של צלמי התרבות וה/rs. ב- 1979 הוצרף לתאחדות הצלמים המקביעים וב- 1985 נבחר לנשיאות.

החל משנת 1974 החל ג'ברא ללמד בתיכון הספר החקלאות לצילום – בא"ל, מכללת הדסה, ומכללת קריית אונו. הוא ראה את יי"ד העדotta בהנדנות דור חדש של צלמים מקביעים ולآخر 30 שנות פעילות מרתוקת צילם בחור להתמסר בתחום זה והסביר את הסטודיו של, ברחוב העבודה 24 לቤת ספר לצילום, על פי מודל שלמדו להכיר ב藝術ת התרבות. מלבד אהבתו לצלום צילום, ולימוד השפה המקצועית, הקנה ג'ברא לתלמידיו, בראב'ם צילומים פעילים בתחום דרכם, כלים מעשיים לעובדה בתחום הצלמים. הוא צרף אליו את טוב הצלמים בארץ ויצר להם לימוד-ת-תשפחתית.

בשנת 2001 יצא לאור ספר "תמונה בשחור-בלב" והוא הזמין השואה בושגנבו לסדרת יס"ר את ספר ההالة המיחיד של משפחתו.

ג'ברא נפטר בפברואר 2006, במאצ'ה העבודה על ספר השמי שהראה אמרו להיוולד סדרת יס"ר את ספר ההالة בתומו של ג'ברא, רותי מנדייל-תלב.




