




### Example: Type - Study skills and click the search button








You can opt to write down the quick location, and call number if available. You can click on the provided icons for Email, Cite, URL link, and for creating a temporary list.





#### 6) Scroll down the screen to the Availability or Holding Summary






If the book is located at Blazer Library, you simply go to the shelf and retrieve the book. If it is online then sign in using your CWID. Contact the Reference Desk for assistance.


### **Interlibrary loan**

## **ADVANCED SEARCH**


The "Advanced" search option allows you to perform expert and selected databases searches. At the WorldCat Discovery search screen box click on ADVANCED SEARCH. Use the fields, limiters, add more rows as desired, as well as use the boolean operators of AND, OR, NOT.


