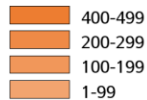
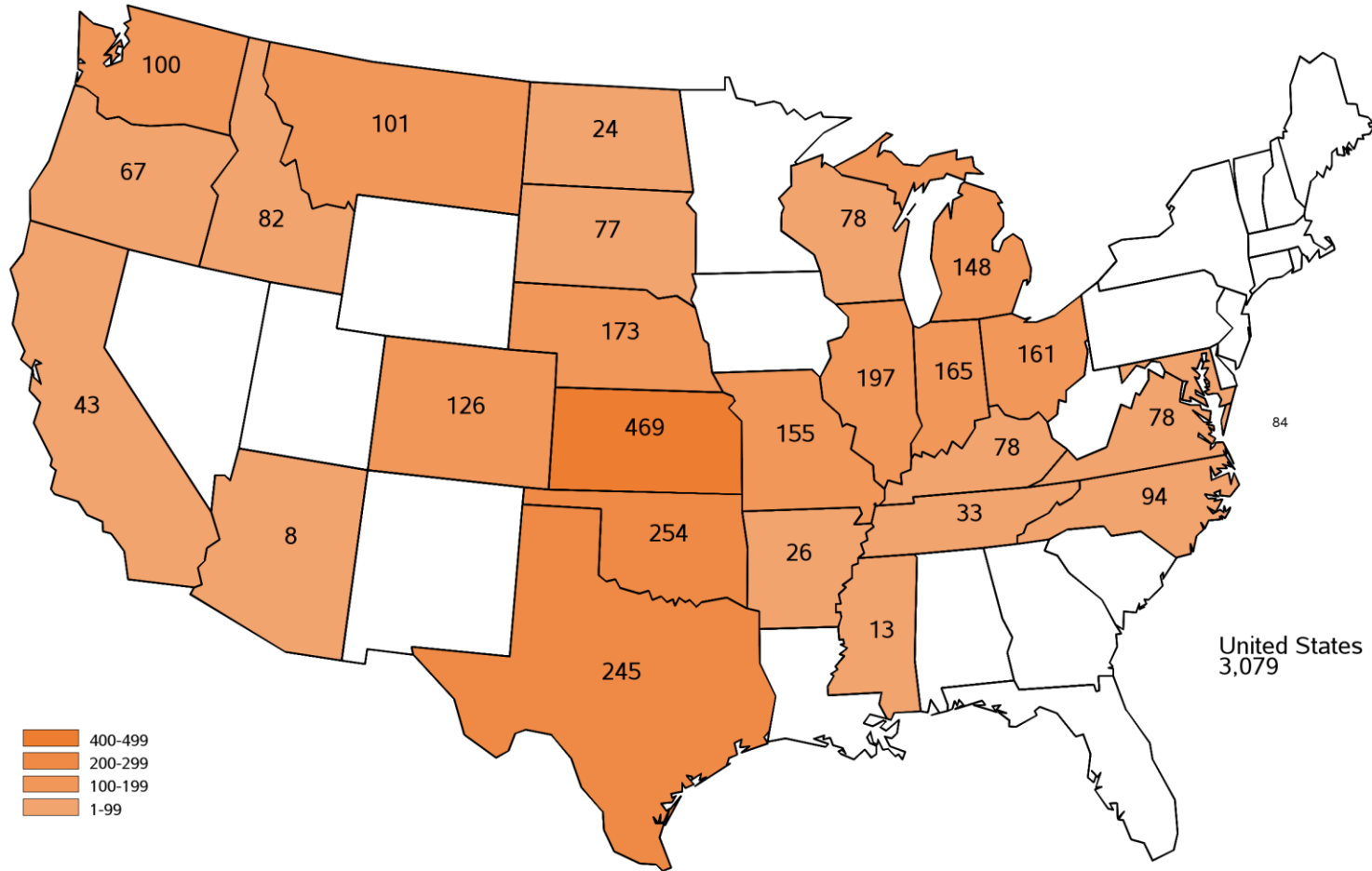

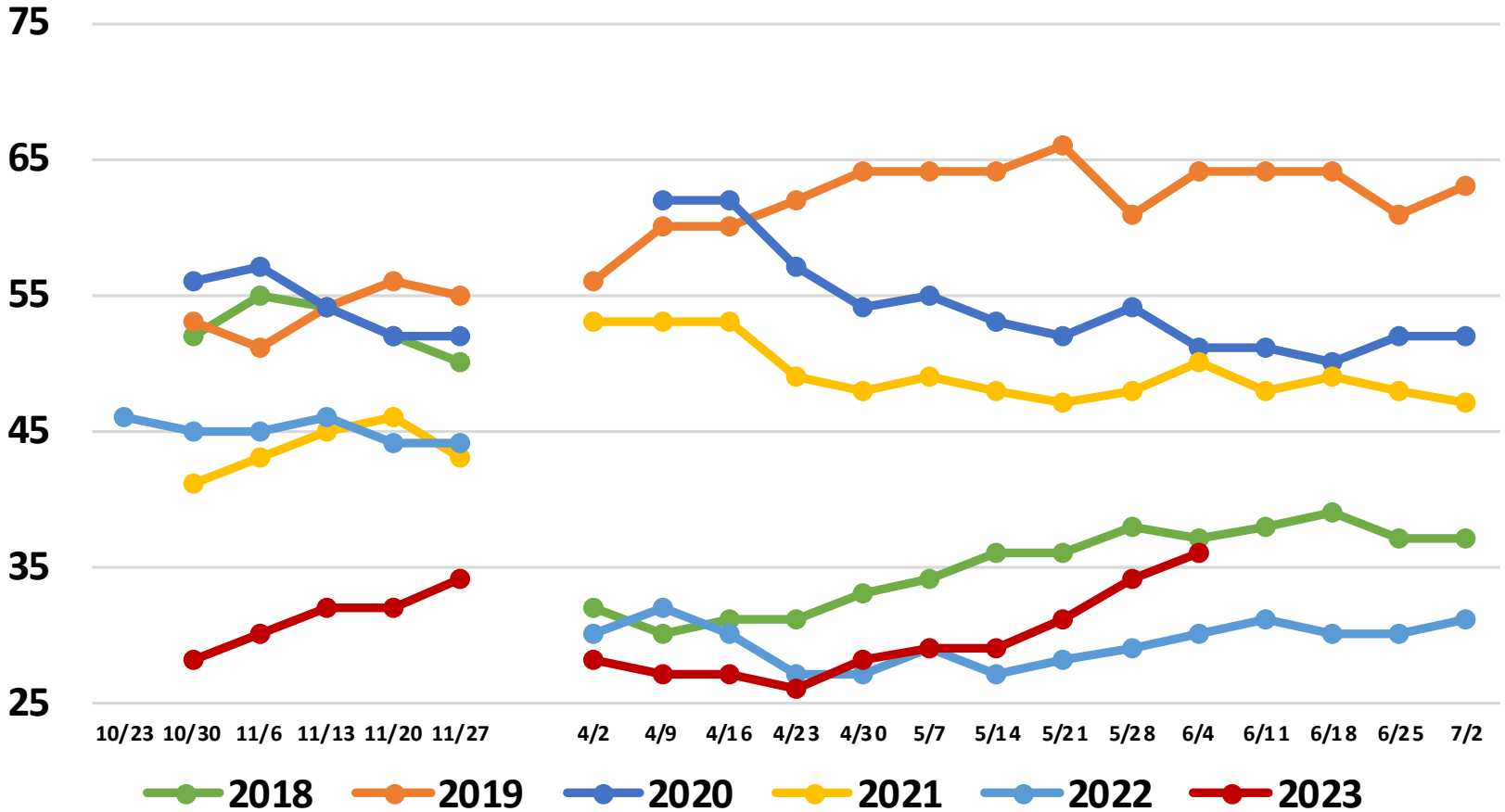




United States Winter Wheat Condition

Percent Rated Good to Excellent

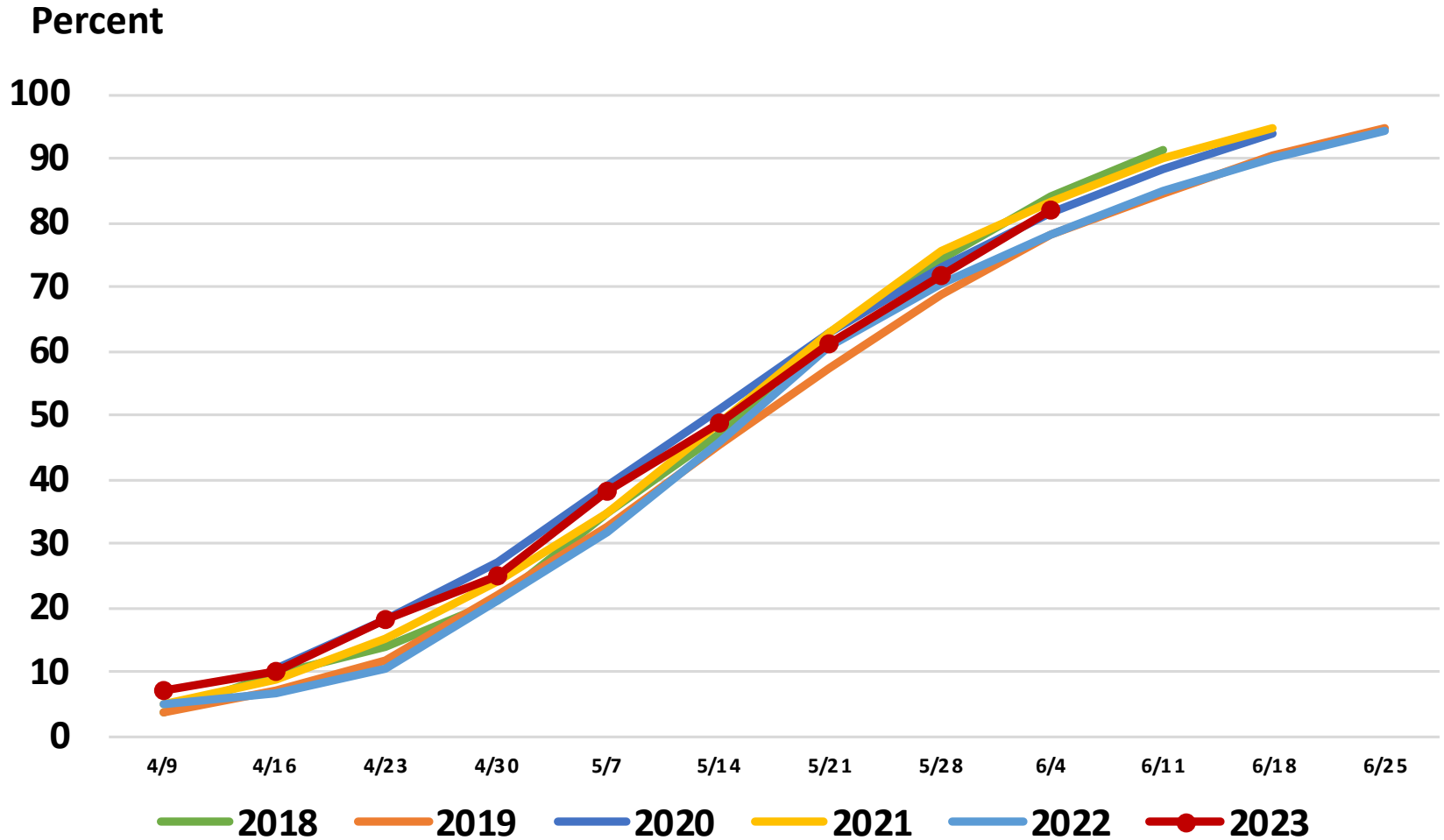

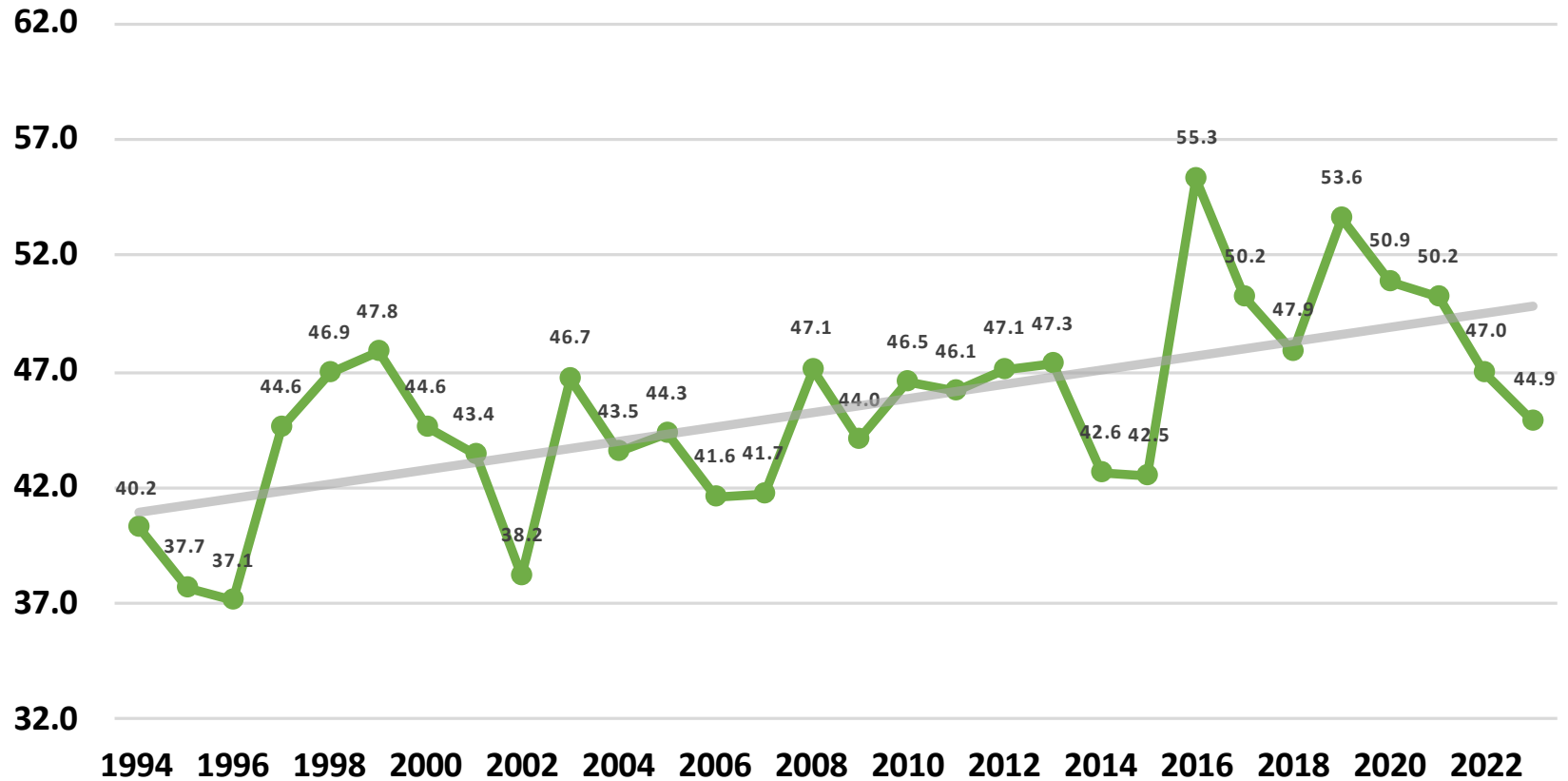

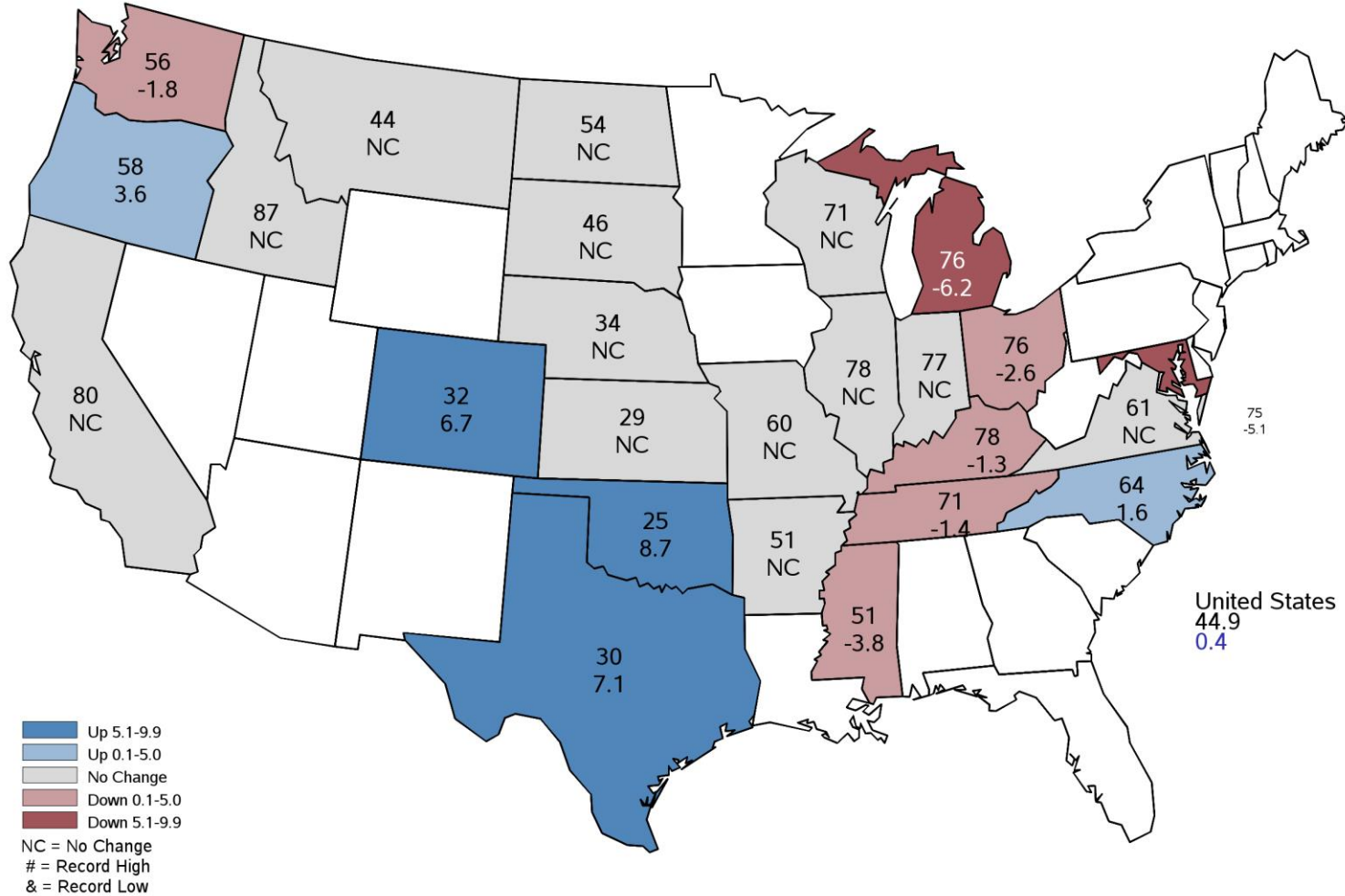

Bushels per Acre



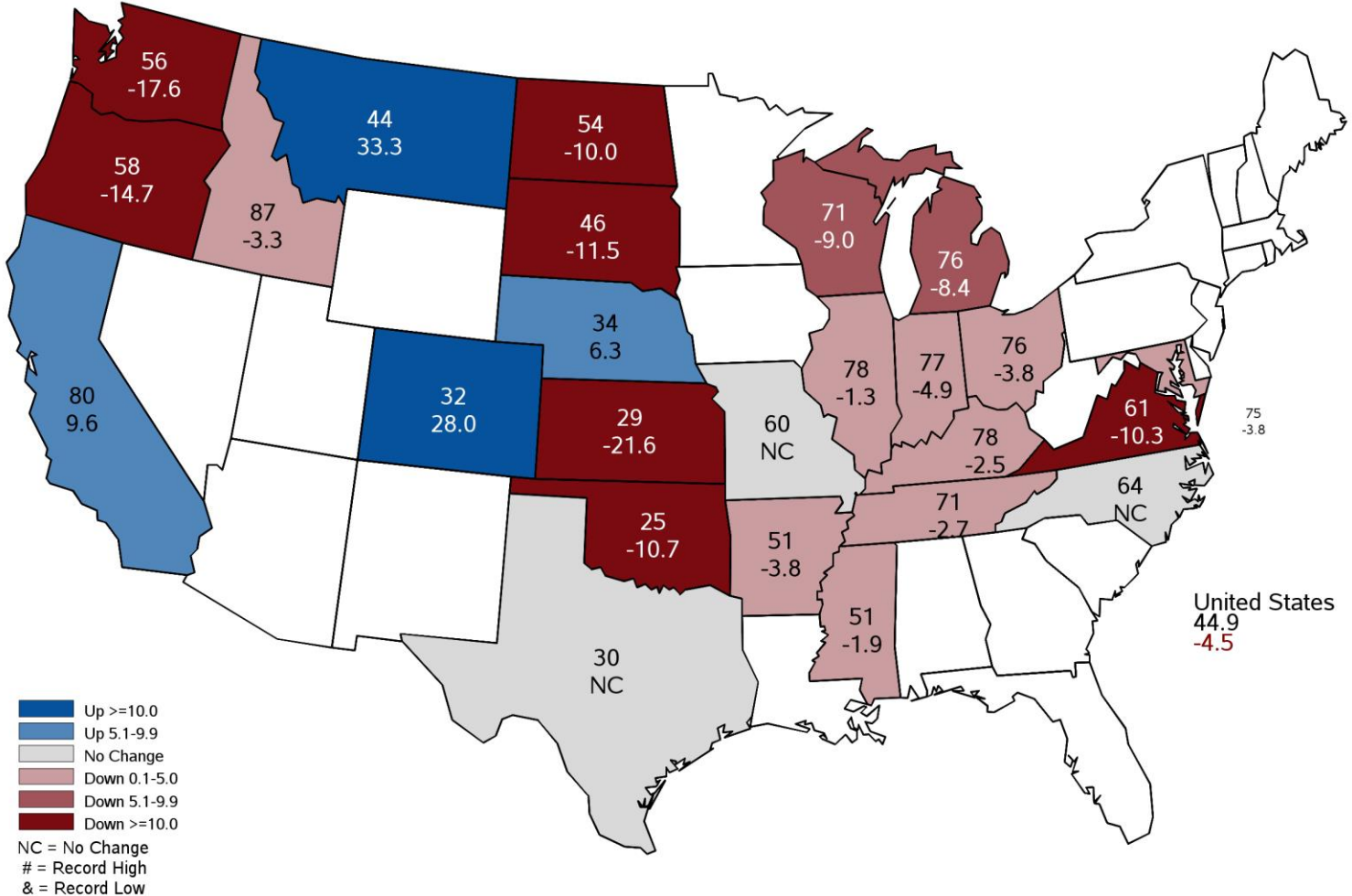
June 2023 Winter Wheat Yield

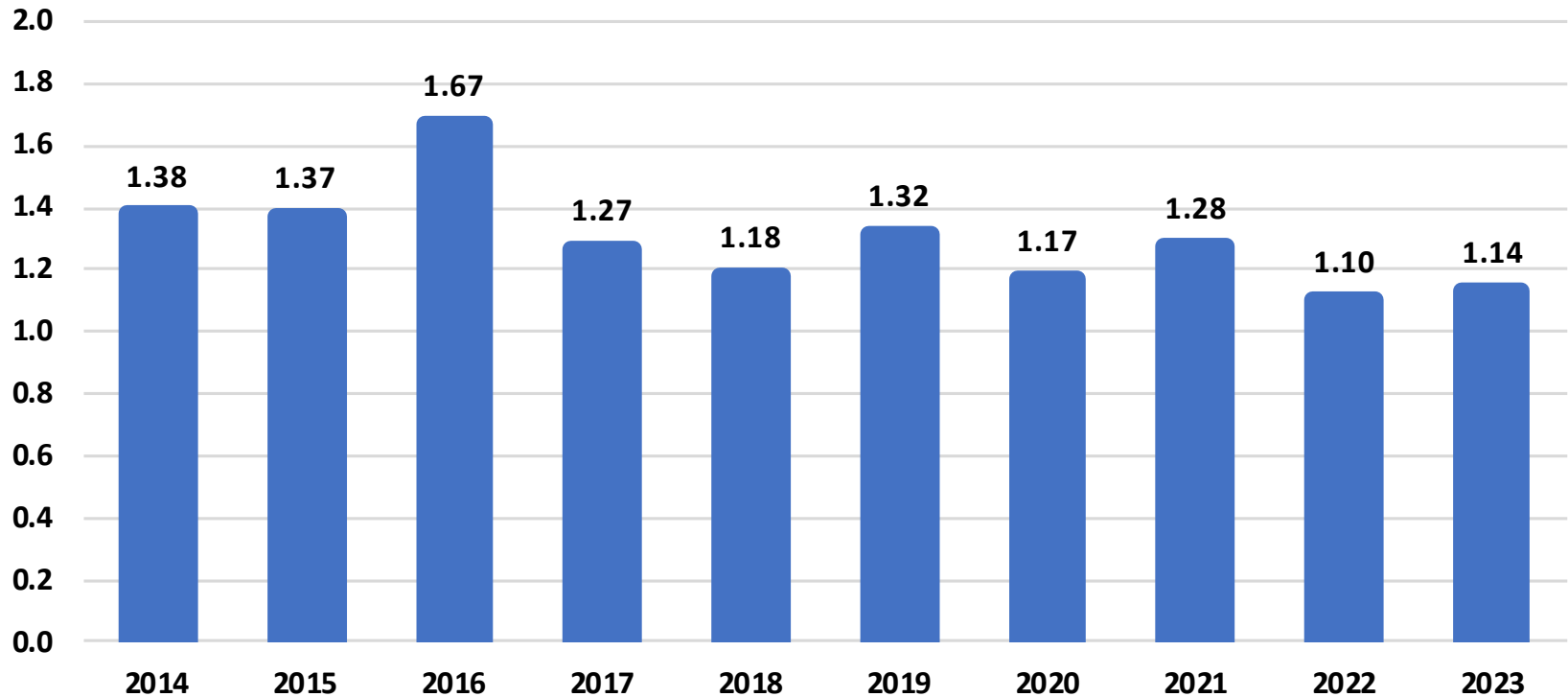

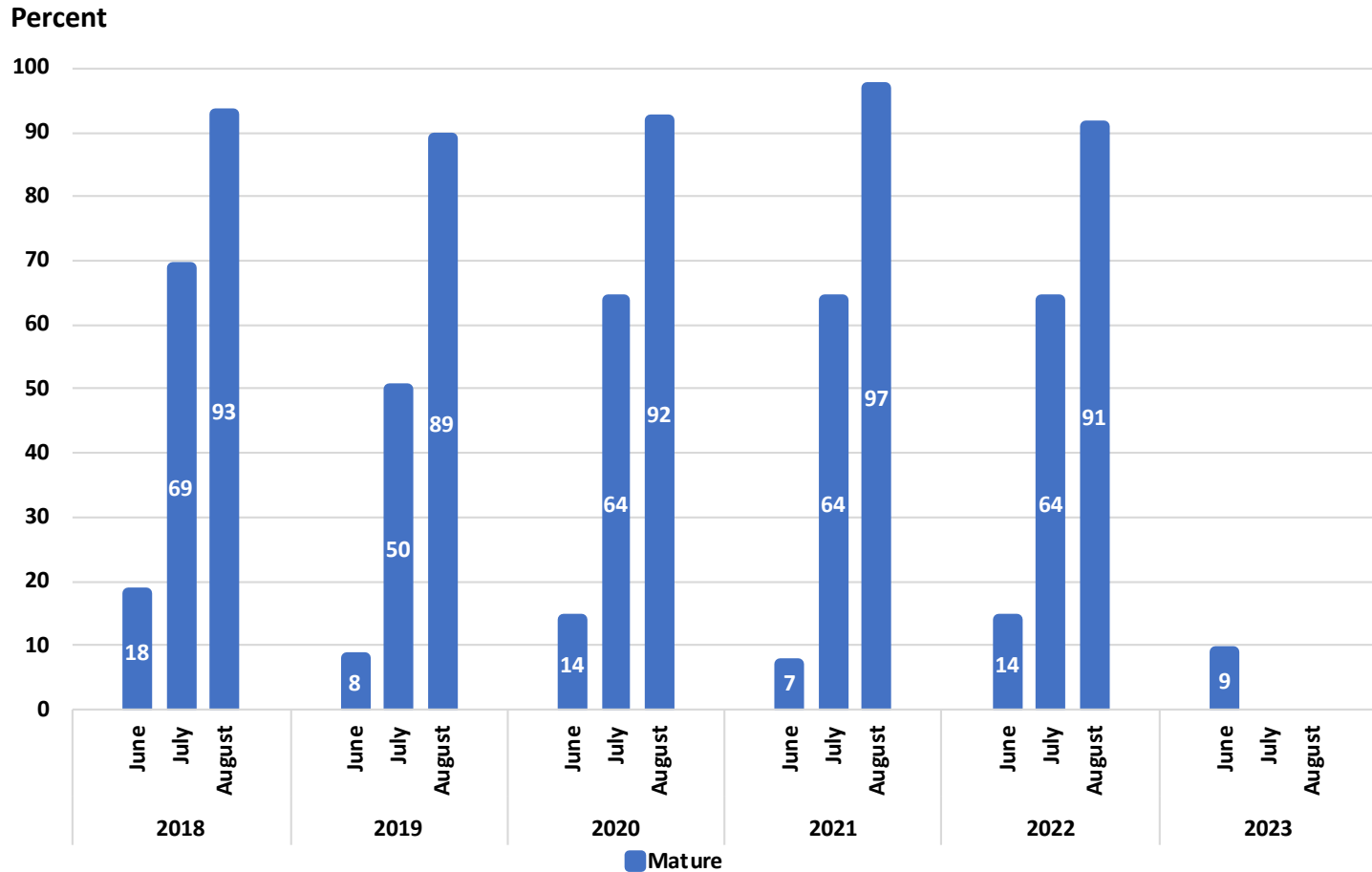

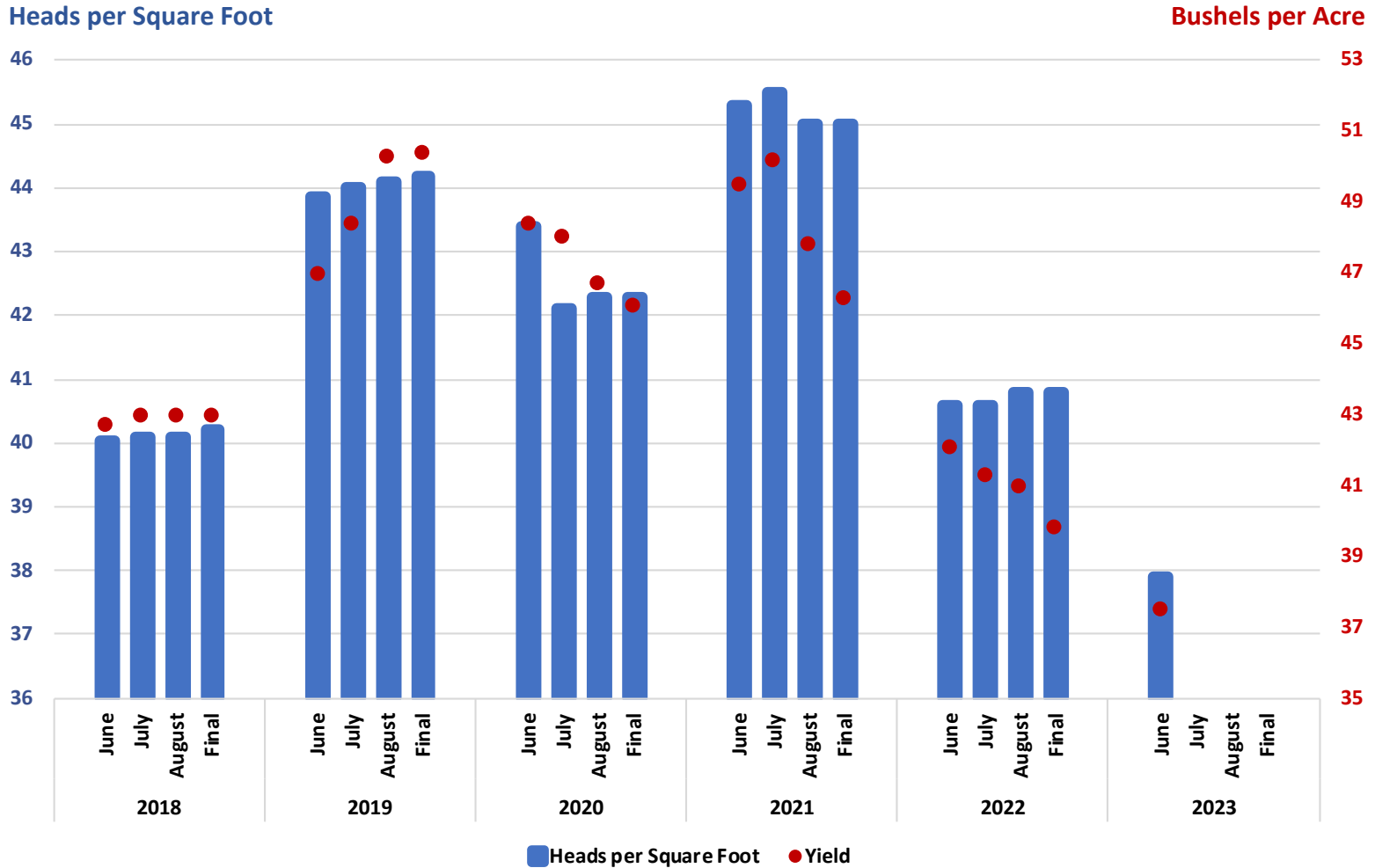
Percent of Samples Processed in the Lab

Heads per Square Foot and Yield for 10 State Region



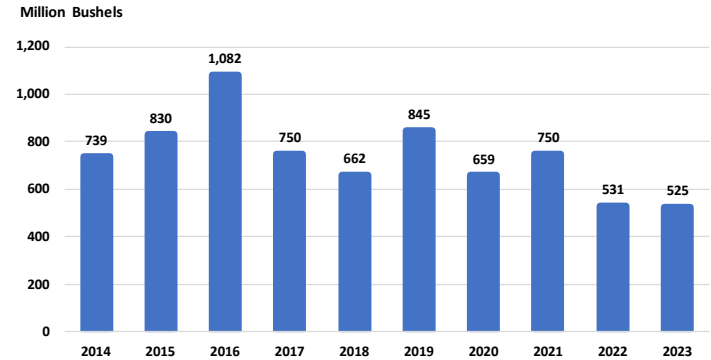

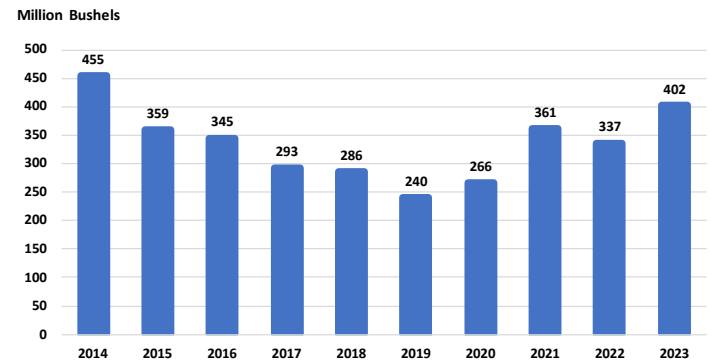

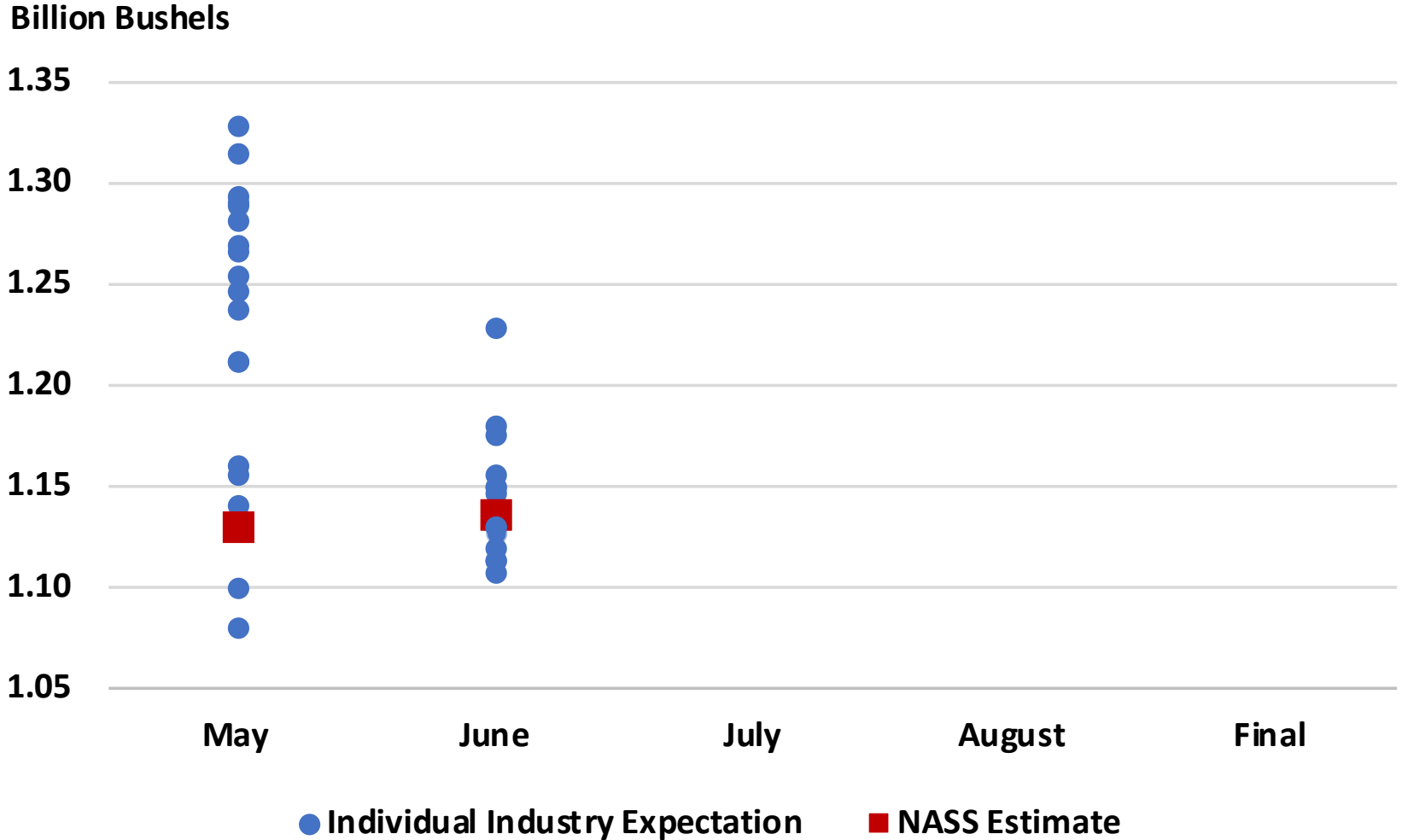

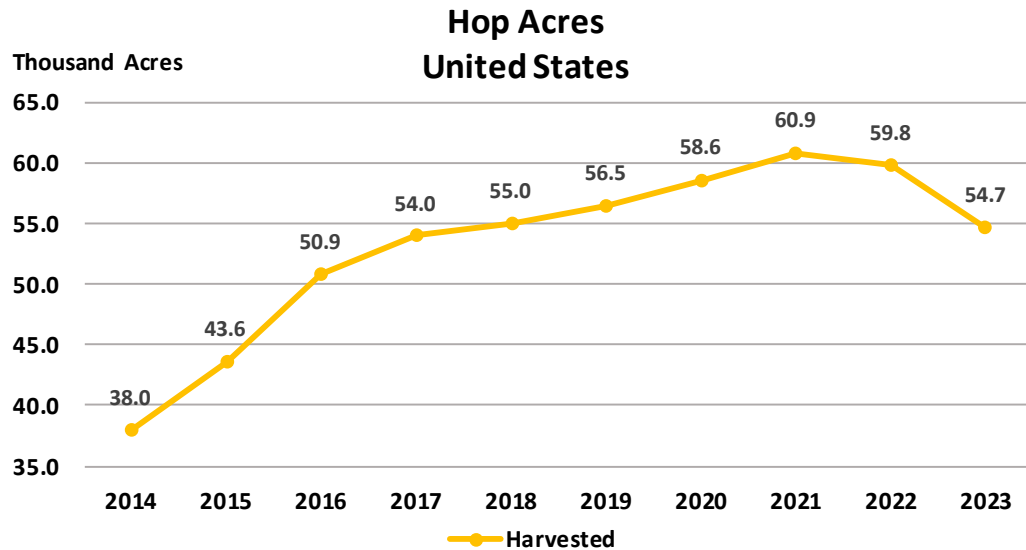

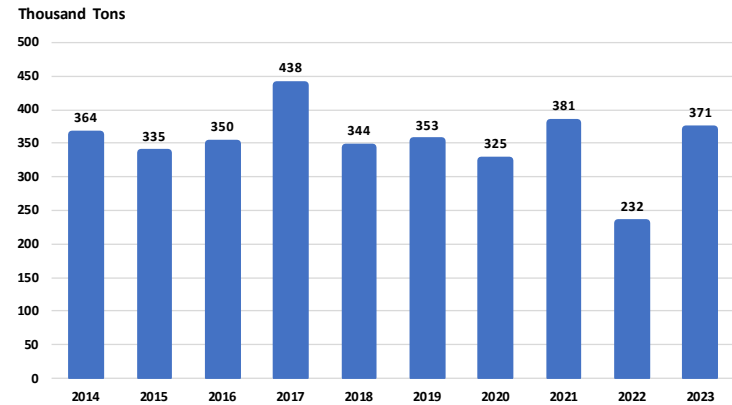

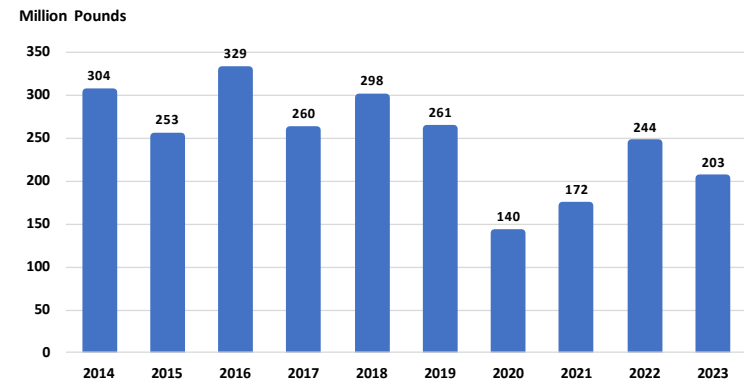
Sweet Cherry Production United States

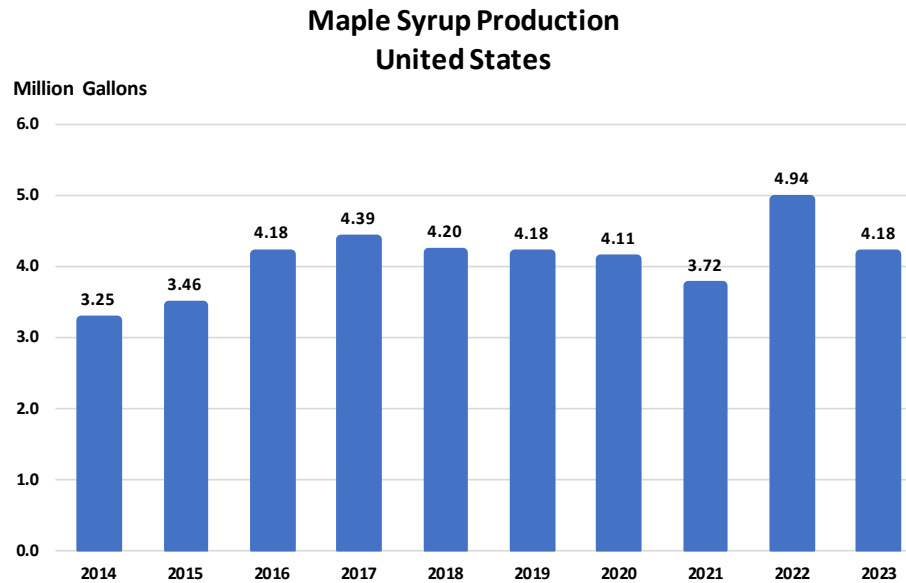

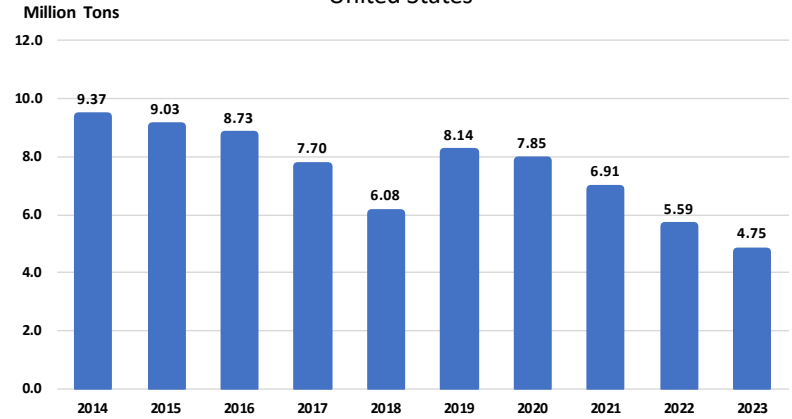

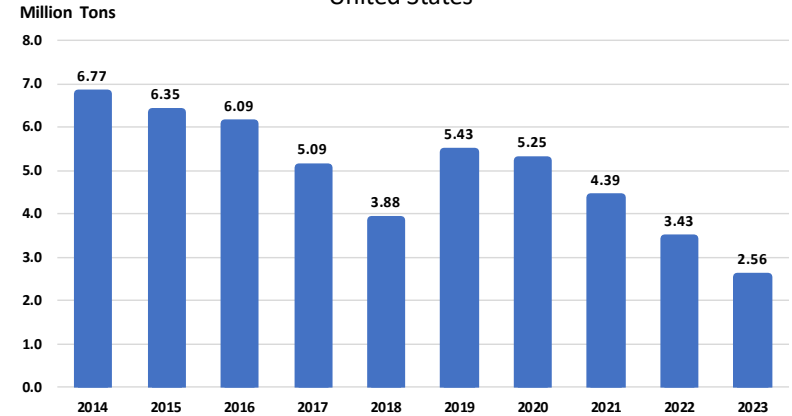
